Methodology – 2020: Wave 2 (September)

- Online nationwide survey conducted among n=1,272 young people ages 15 to 21
- Survey respondents include:
 - 209 white females, 207 white males
 - 206 Black females, 206 Black males
 - 208 Hispanic females, 203 Hispanic males
 - 345 youth ages 15-16
 - 264 youth ages 17-18
 - 663 youth ages 19-21
 - Note: parents/guardians provided written consent prior to minors being surveyed
- Margin of error for n=1,272 is +/- 2.7 percentage points; higher for subgroups
- Dates conducted: September 22 – 30, 2020

Methodology – 2020: Wave 1 (August)

- Online nationwide survey conducted among n=1,305 young people ages 15 to 21
- Survey respondents include:
 - 209 white females, 204 white males
 - 203 Black females, 205 Black males
 - 204 Hispanic females, 220 Hispanic males
 - 272 youth ages 15-16
 - 390 youth ages 17-18
 - 643 youth ages 19-21
 - Note: parents/guardians provided written consent prior to minors being surveyed
- Margin of error for n=1,305 is +/- 2.7 percentage points; higher for subgroups
- Dates conducted: August 8 – 16, 2020

Methodology – 2019

- Online nationwide survey conducted among n=2,638 young people ages 15 to 21
- Survey respondents include:
 - 370 white females, 386 white males
 - 486 Black females, 451 Black males
 - 499 Hispanic females 398 Hispanic males
 - 528 youth ages 15-16
 - 676 youth ages 17-18
 - 1434 youth ages 19-21
 - Note: parents/guardians provided written consent prior to minors being surveyed
- Margin of error for n=2,638 is +/- 1.9 percentage points; higher for subgroups
- Dates conducted: September 16 – 22, 2019

KEY FINDINGS

Key Findings (1 of 4)

- **Racial Justice:** Most respondents support the protests around racial justice that continue to happen across the country. Support is strongest among Black female, Black male, and Hispanic male respondents.
- **Responsibilities:** COVID continues to have an impact on young people's lives, with many assisting their families by providing care for younger or older people in their homes or using their income to help with necessities.
- **Concern:** While many respondents are *extremely* or *very worried* they will catch the coronavirus, more respondents are concerned someone in their immediate family will catch the virus. Hispanic female respondents and Black female respondents are more concerned about both themselves and their family members than are other race and gender subgroups.
- **Concern for the Future:** Almost four in ten (38%) respondents are *extremely* or *very concerned* the coronavirus pandemic will affect their future job or career prospects. Black male and Hispanic male respondents are the mostly likely to be concerned, while white male respondents are the least likely.

Key Findings (2 of 4)

- **Changing Plans:** A majority of respondents report their future job or career plans have changed, or are likely to change, due to the coronavirus pandemic.
- **Optimism:** A majority of respondents continue to be optimistic they can achieve the kind of life they want in the future, though levels of optimism have dropped compared to 2019.
- **Career Goals:** Notably higher proportions of respondents in Wave 2 report feeling clear about their future job and career goals compared to Wave 1 – although the proportions remain lower across all race and gender subgroups than in 2019.
- **Know Steps to Take:** In Wave 2, there is also a noticeable increase in the proportion of respondents who feel like they know the steps they need to take to achieve their job and career goals, compared to Wave 1.
 - The proportions of Black female and Black male respondents who feel this way are back at the higher 2019 levels.
 - Notably, it is not yet possible to tell if these changes from Wave 1 to Wave 2 are temporary deviations or long-term trends in the data.

Key Findings (3 of 4)

- **Education:** Many respondents feel both the quality and the experience of their education is worse during this COVID-era.
- **Education:** The vast majority of respondents have engaged in some type of online learning since the COVID pandemic started.
 - Most of these respondents have had a live, interactive class experience or a mix of live and pre-recorded, although about a quarter (22%) have only experienced pre-recorded online learning.
- **Education:** For most respondents who have had positive relationships with their high school teachers, the coronavirus outbreak has changed the nature of that relationship and they are now getting more support from their teachers.
- **Education:** A majority of respondents report their high school has or had classes where they could concurrently earn credit for high school and college – such as a dual enrollment or AP course.
 - Slightly less than half (44%) of respondents report these classes will or did affect which program or major they choose to study after high school.

Key Findings (4 of 4)

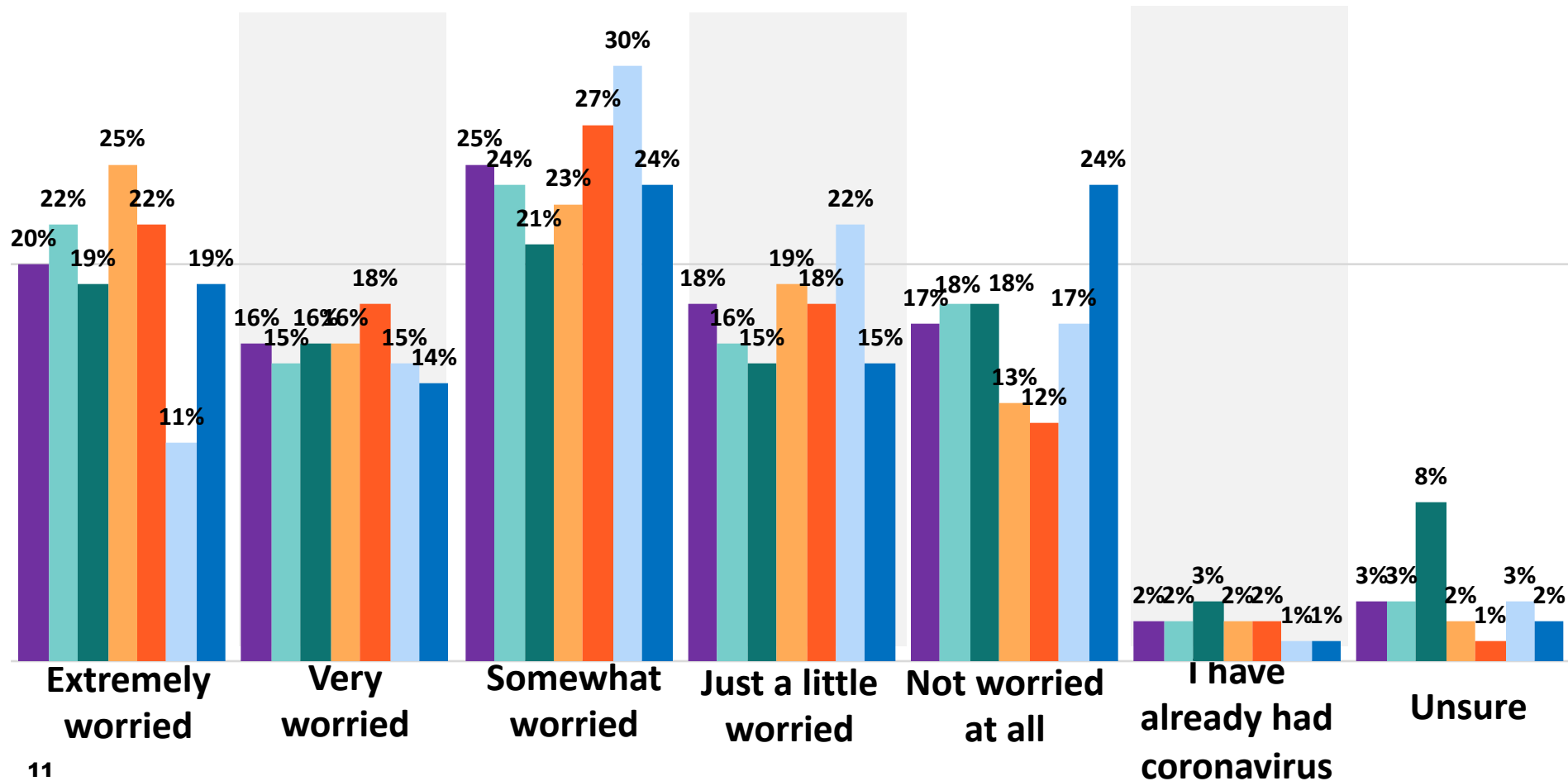
- **Support:** Most respondents report having some type of support with college advising.
 - A majority of respondents feel that most forms of support have a *very* or *somewhat positive* impact.
- **Upskilling:** Almost half of respondents report they are taking or plan to take a training program to develop new skills for their future career.
 - Across racial subgroups, male respondents are more likely than female respondents to report they are currently participating in such a program.
- **Family:** Many respondents feel it is important to stay close to home and family when considering attending college.
 - Notably, at least one-third of respondents in every race and gender subgroup say staying close to home and family is (or would be) much more important to them now than before the coronavirus outbreak.

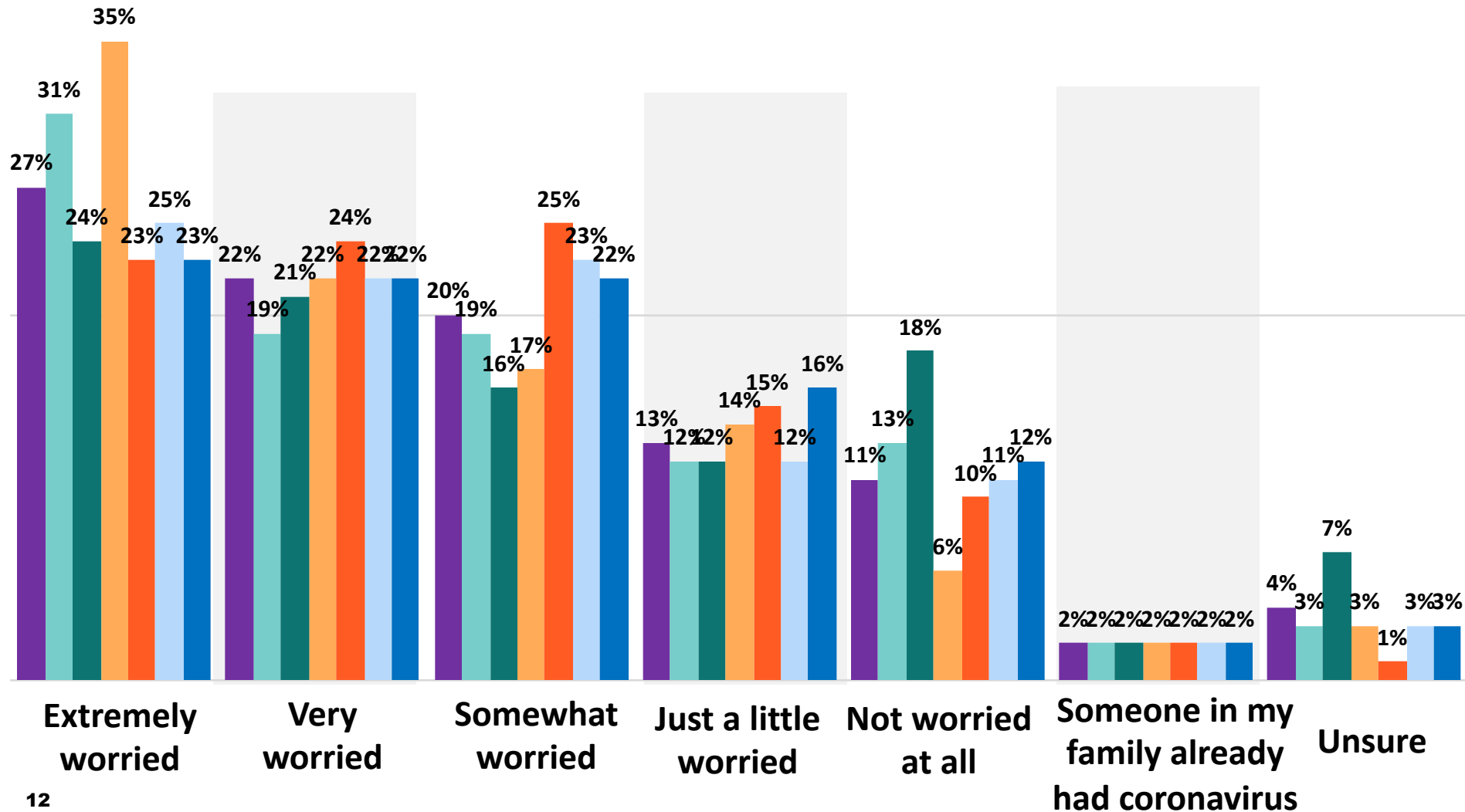

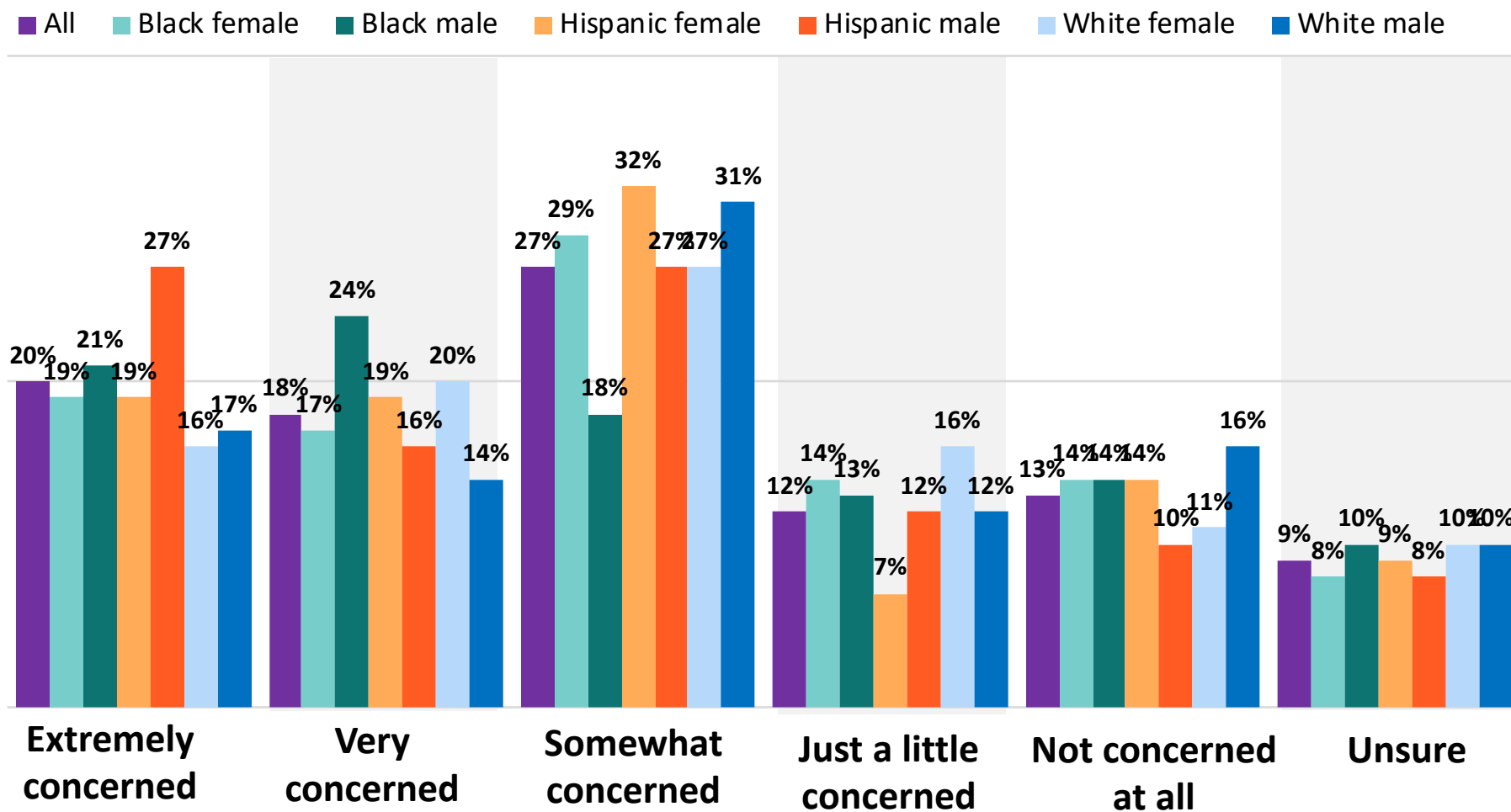
How worried are you that someone in your immediate family will catch the coronavirus?

How concerned are you that the coronavirus will affect your future job or career prospects?

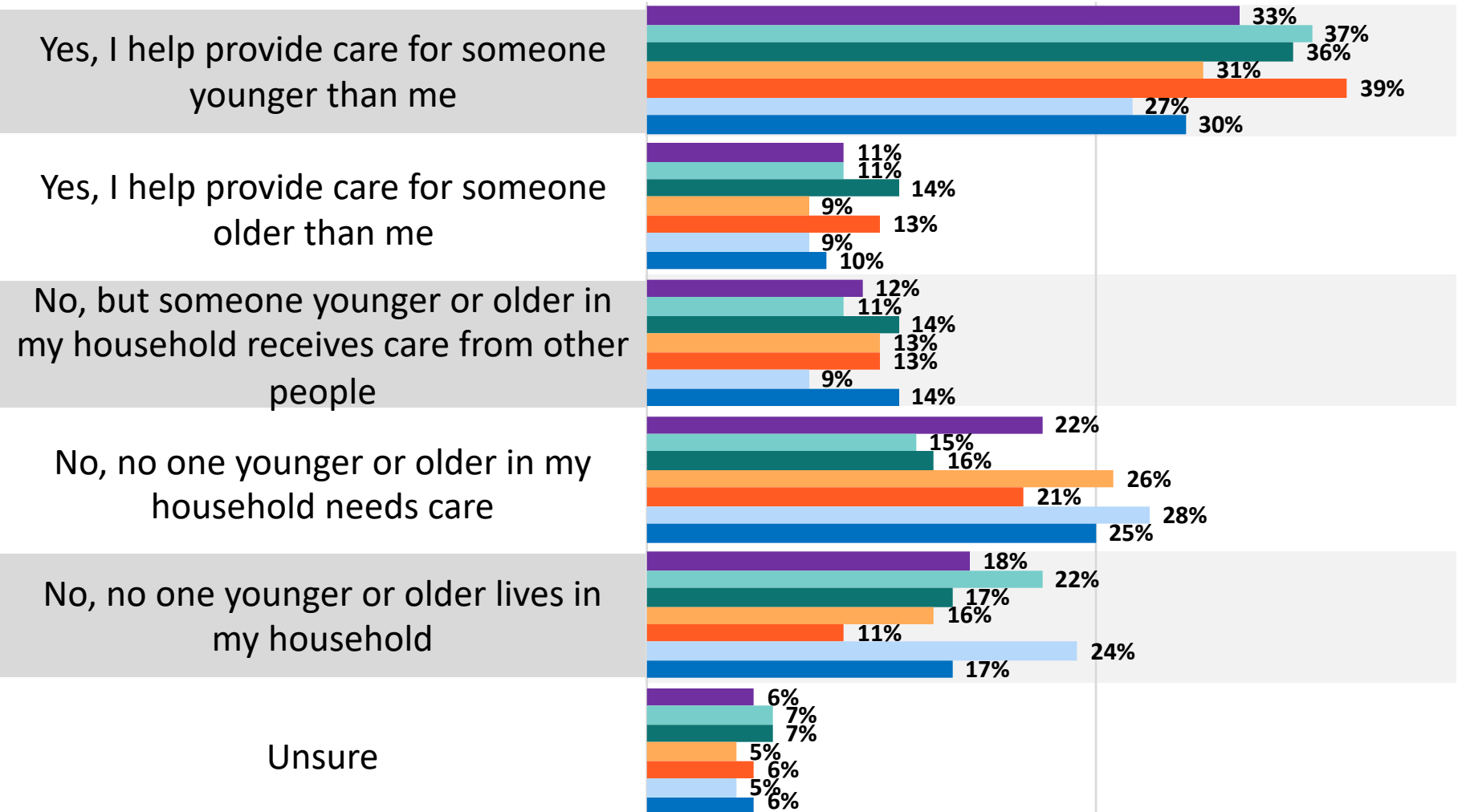

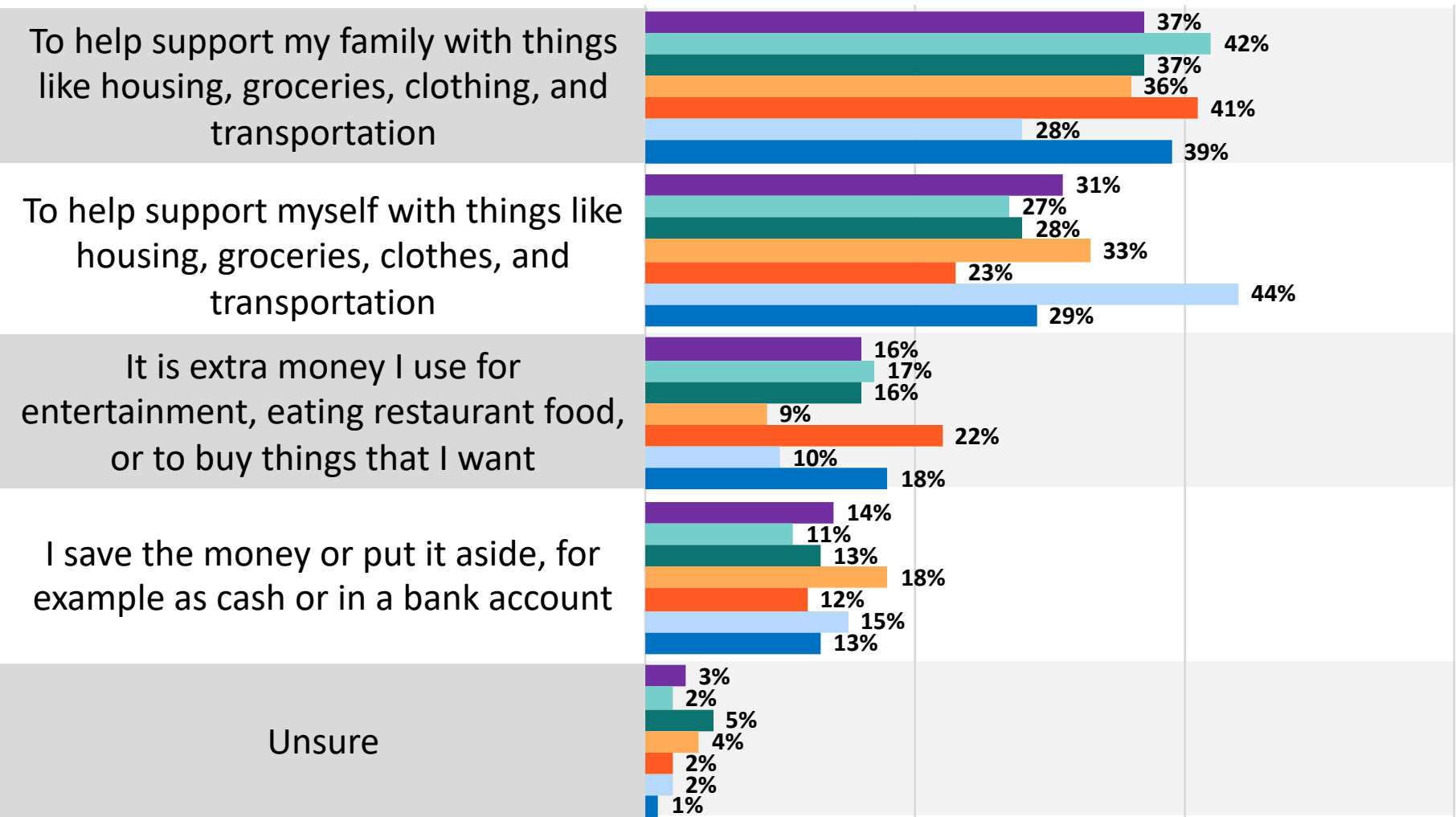

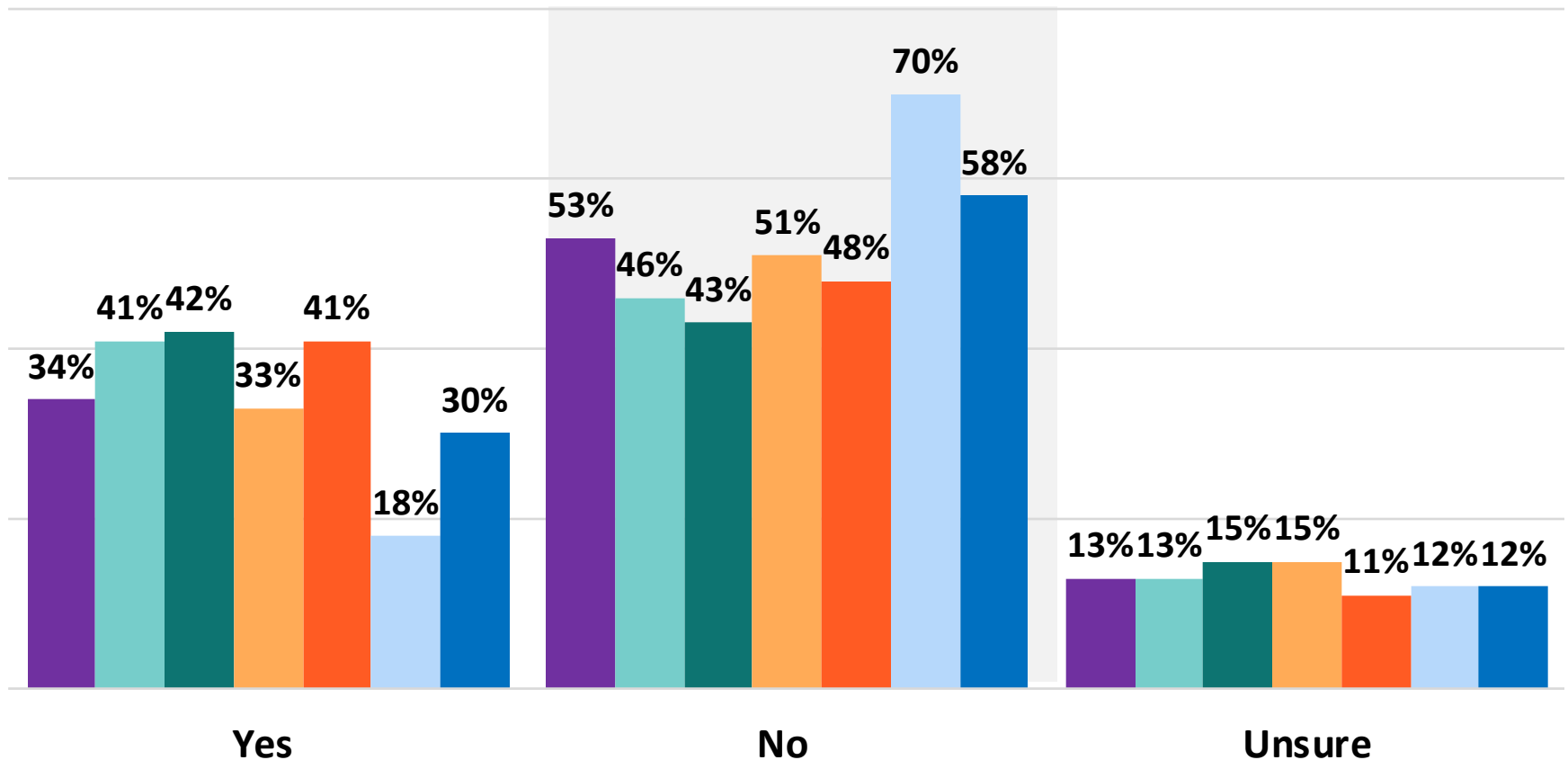

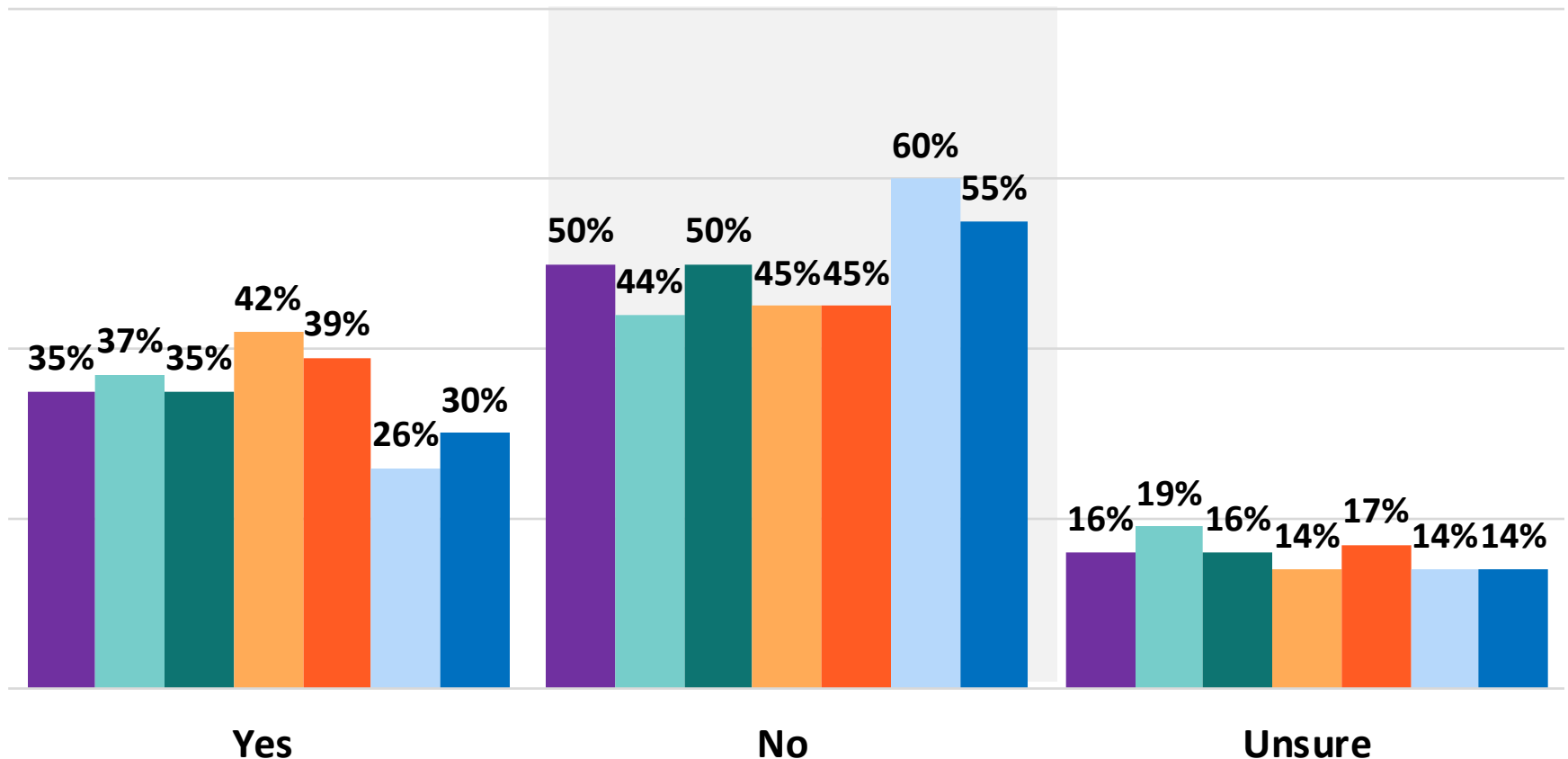

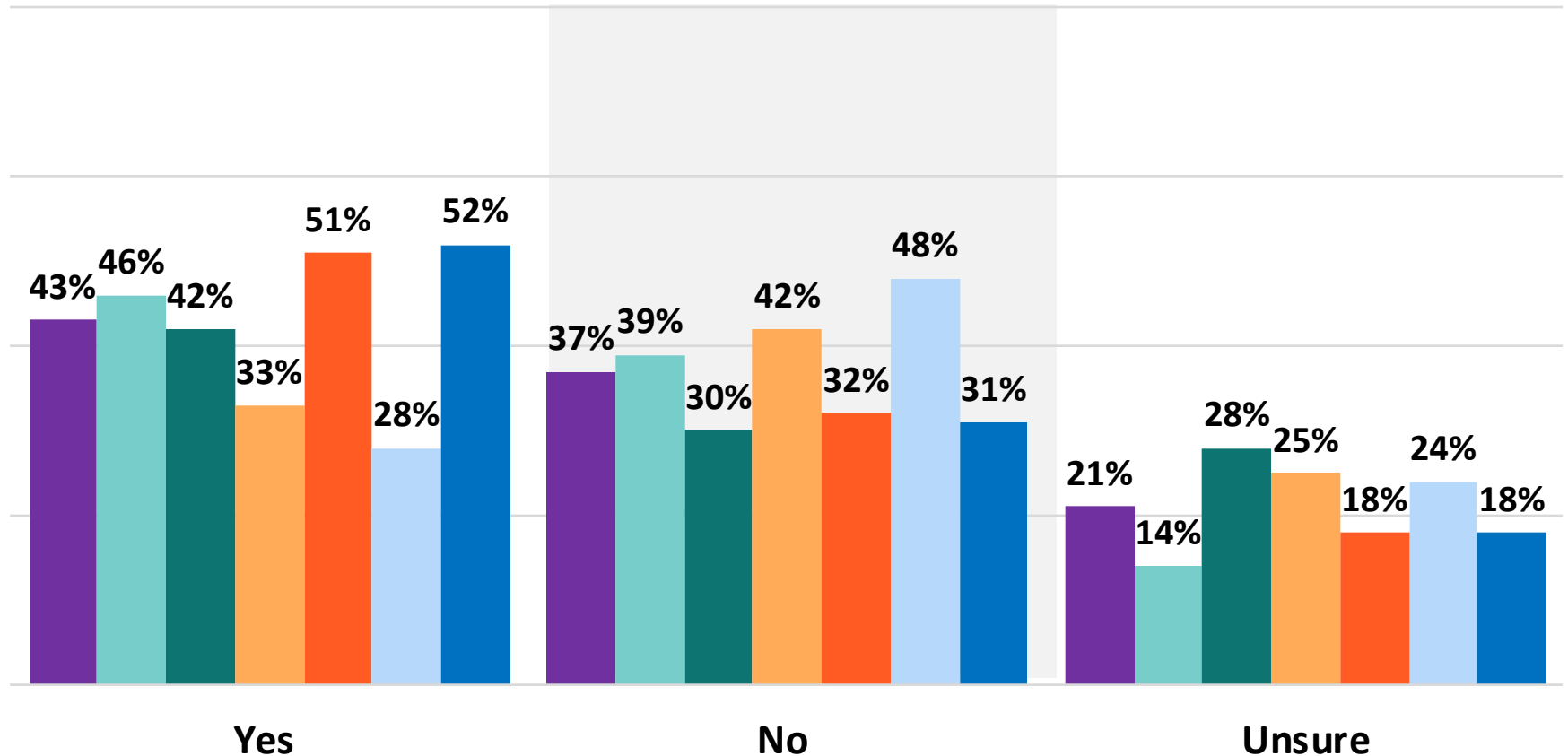

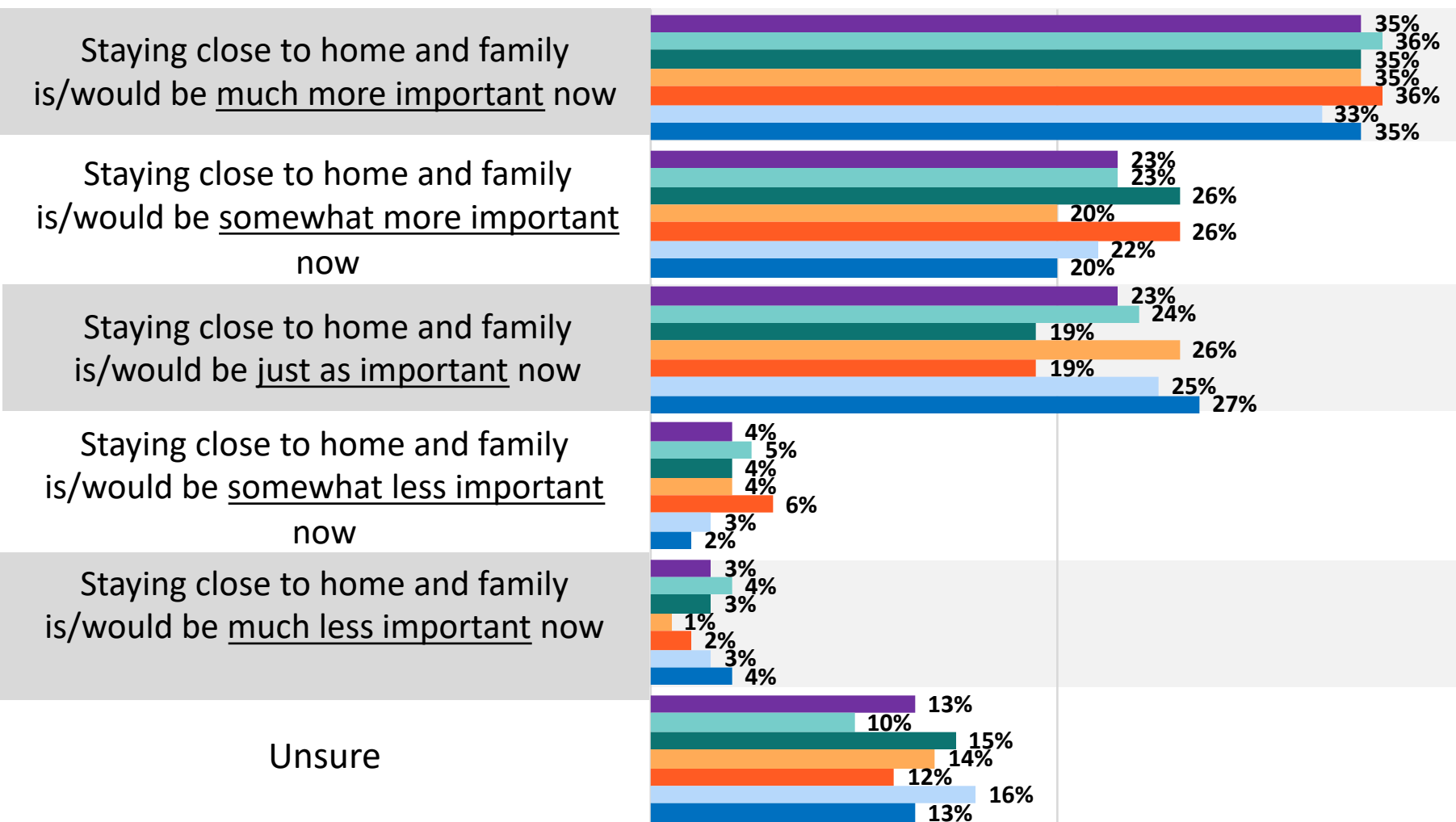

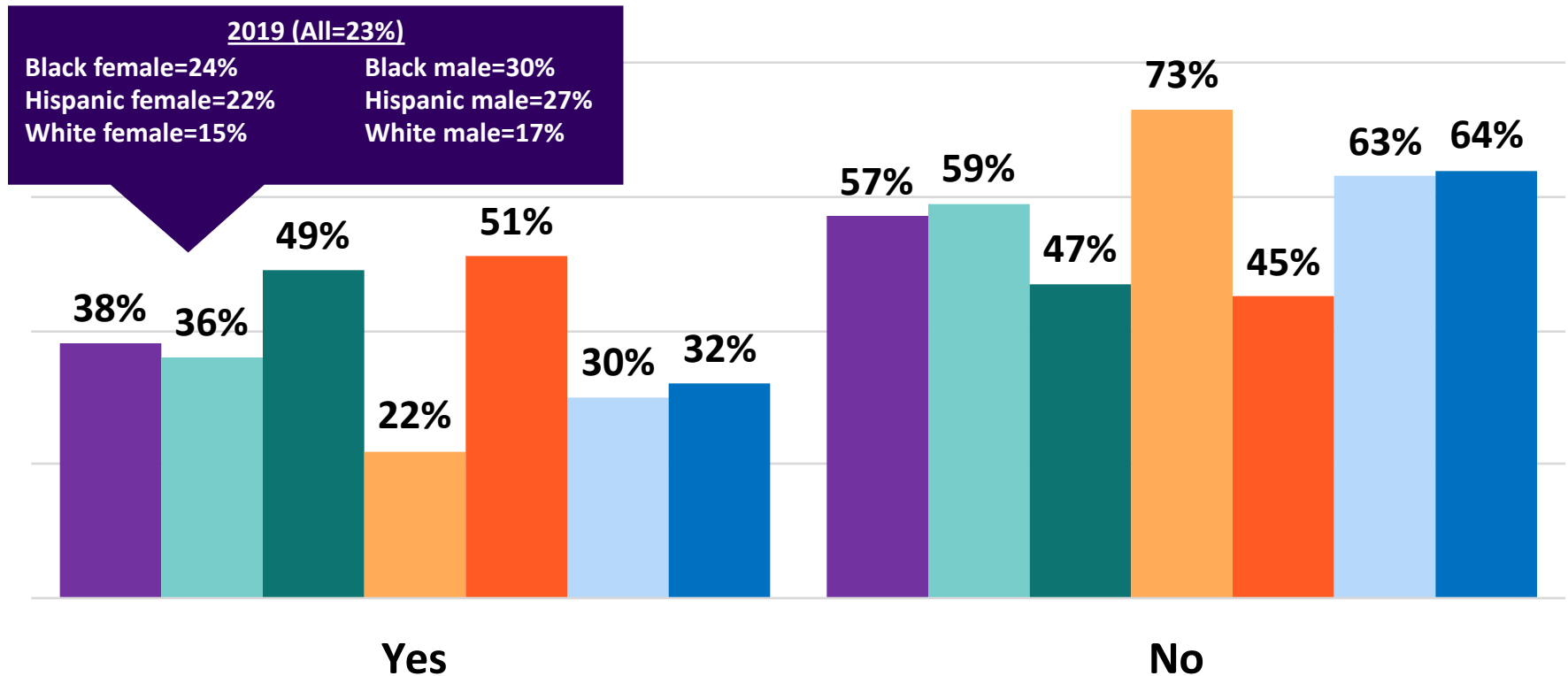

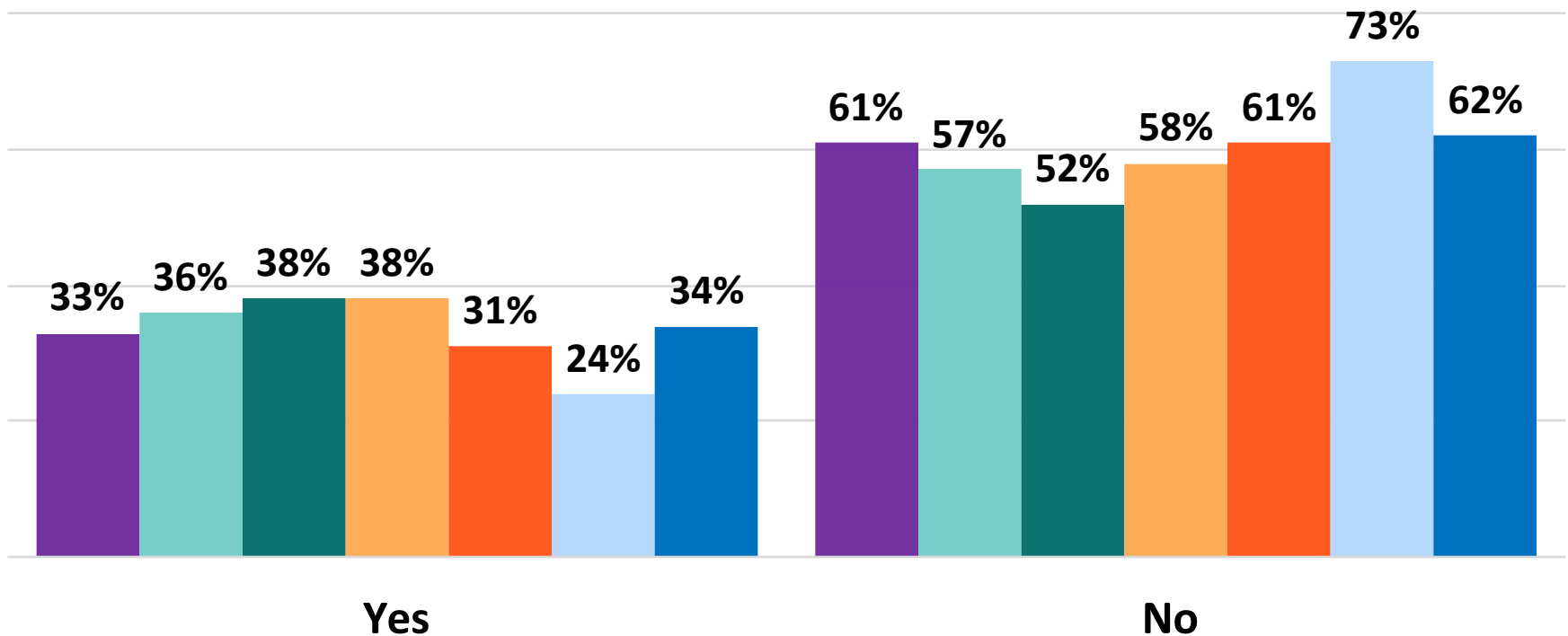

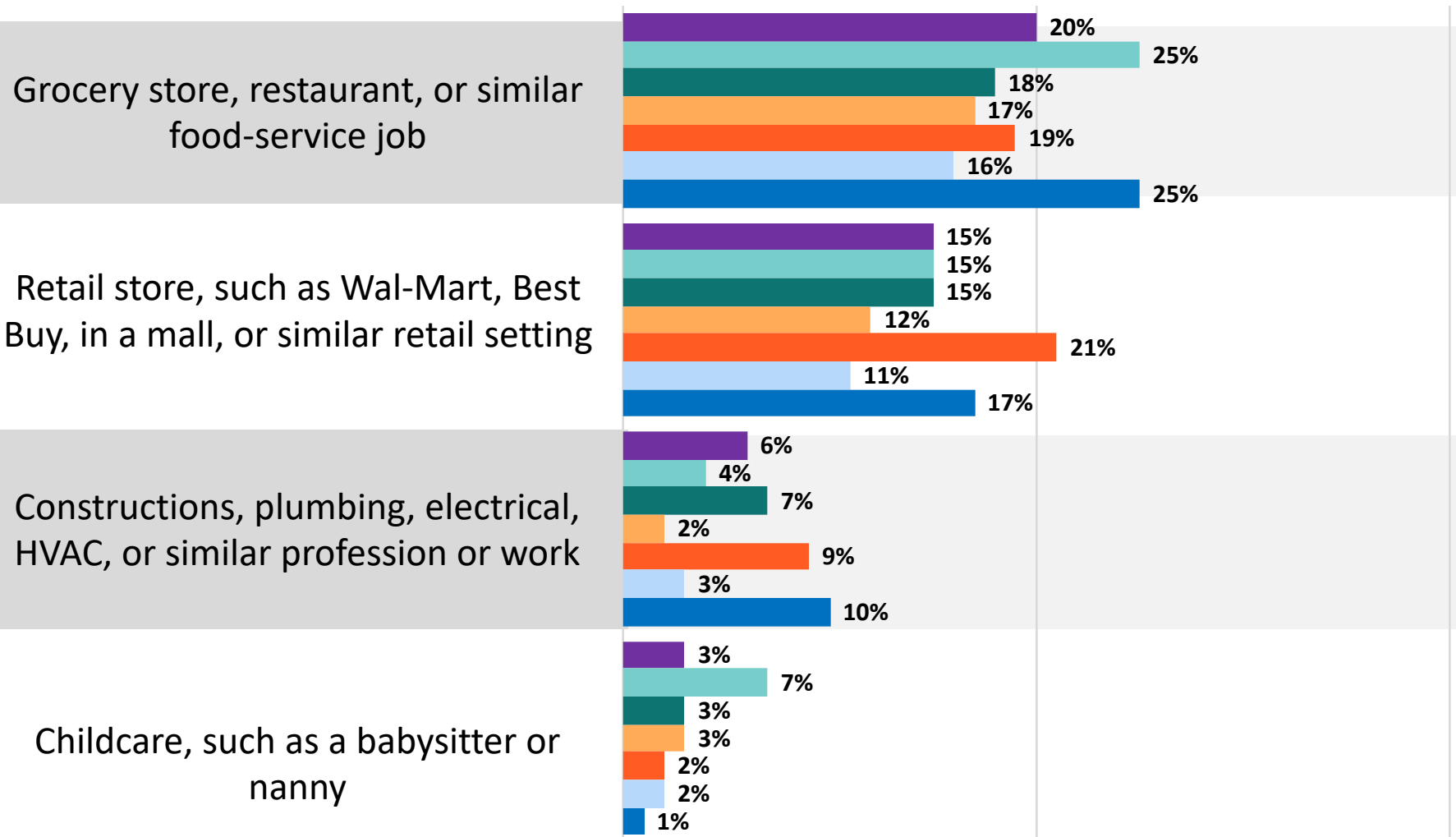

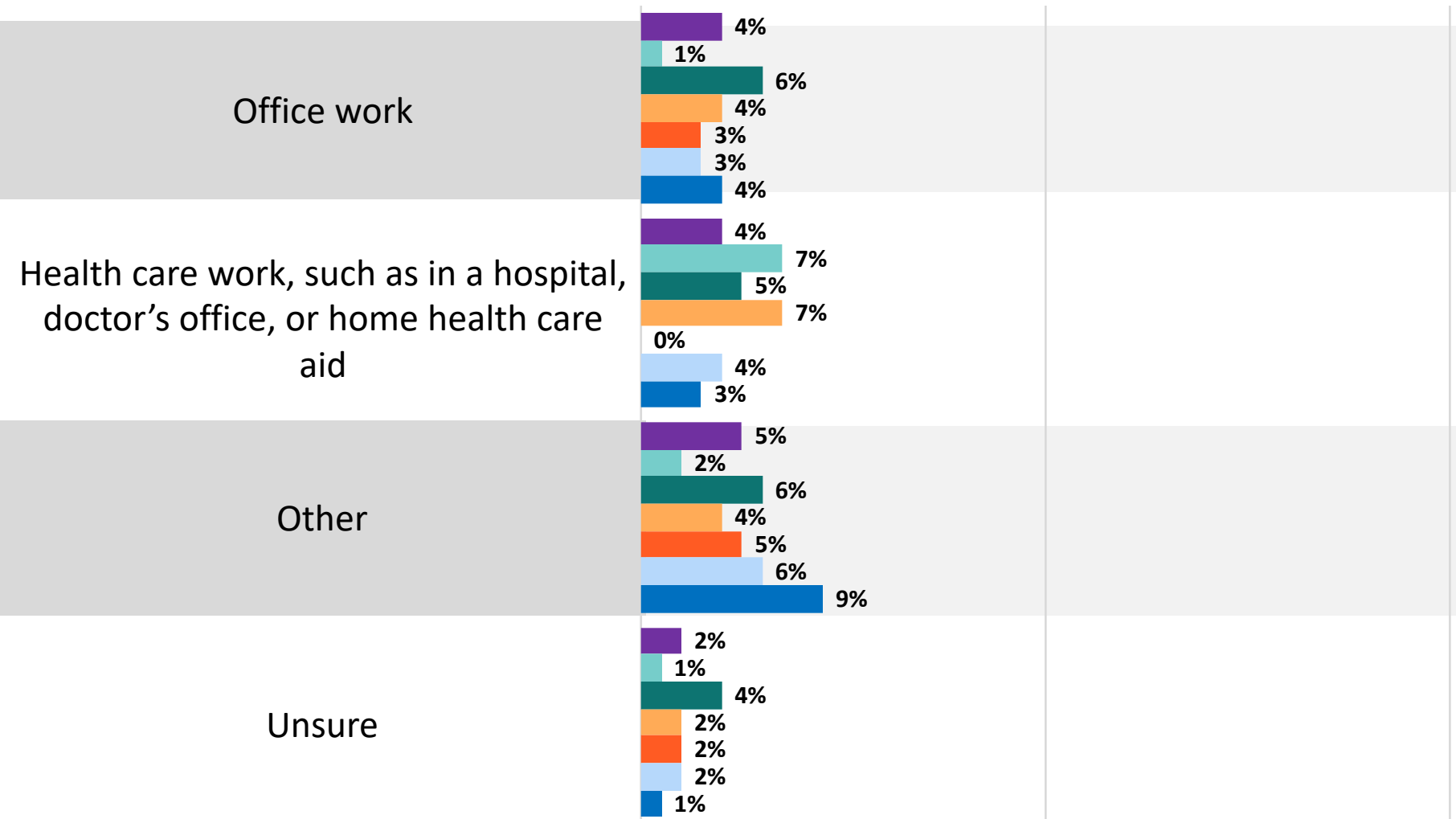

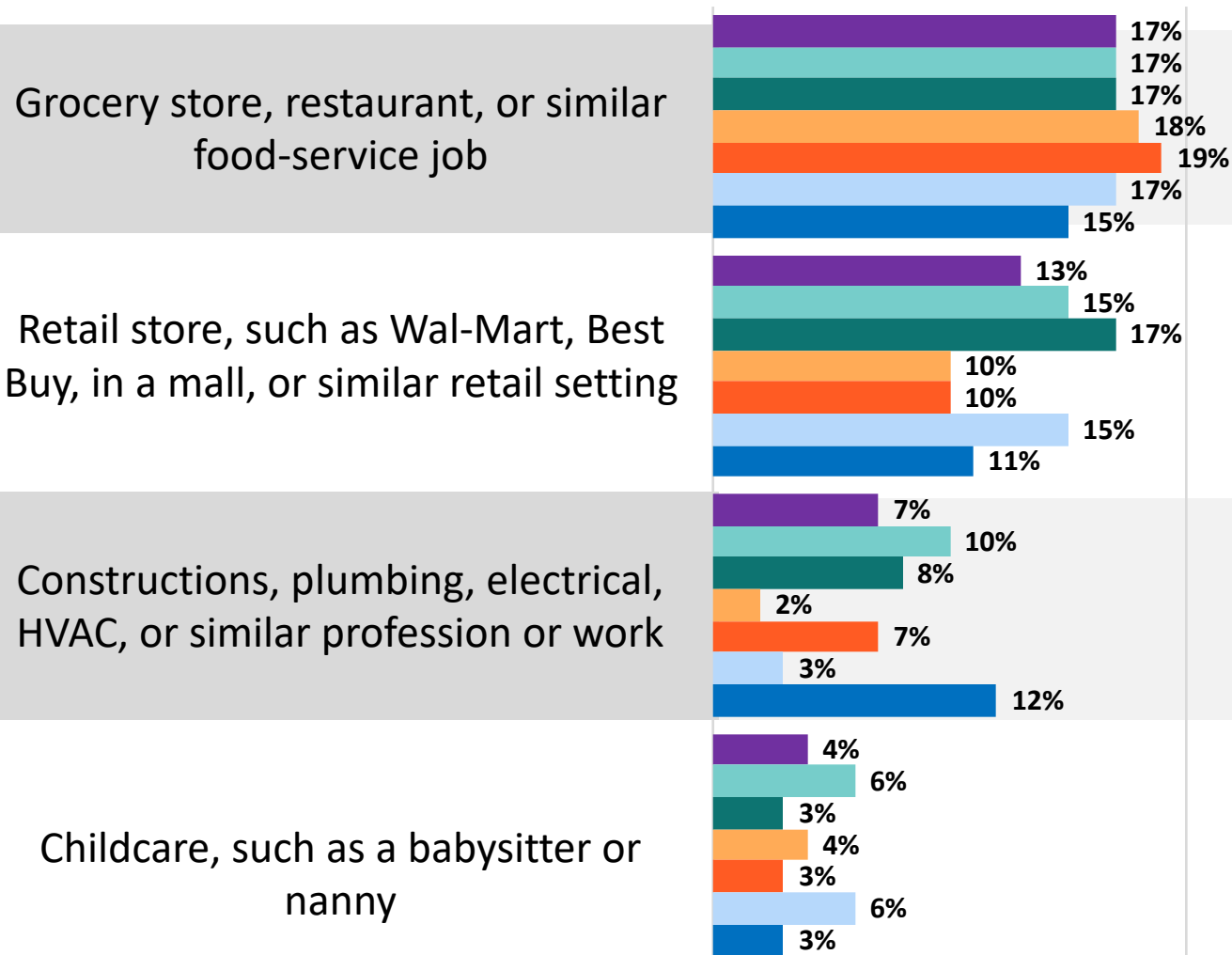

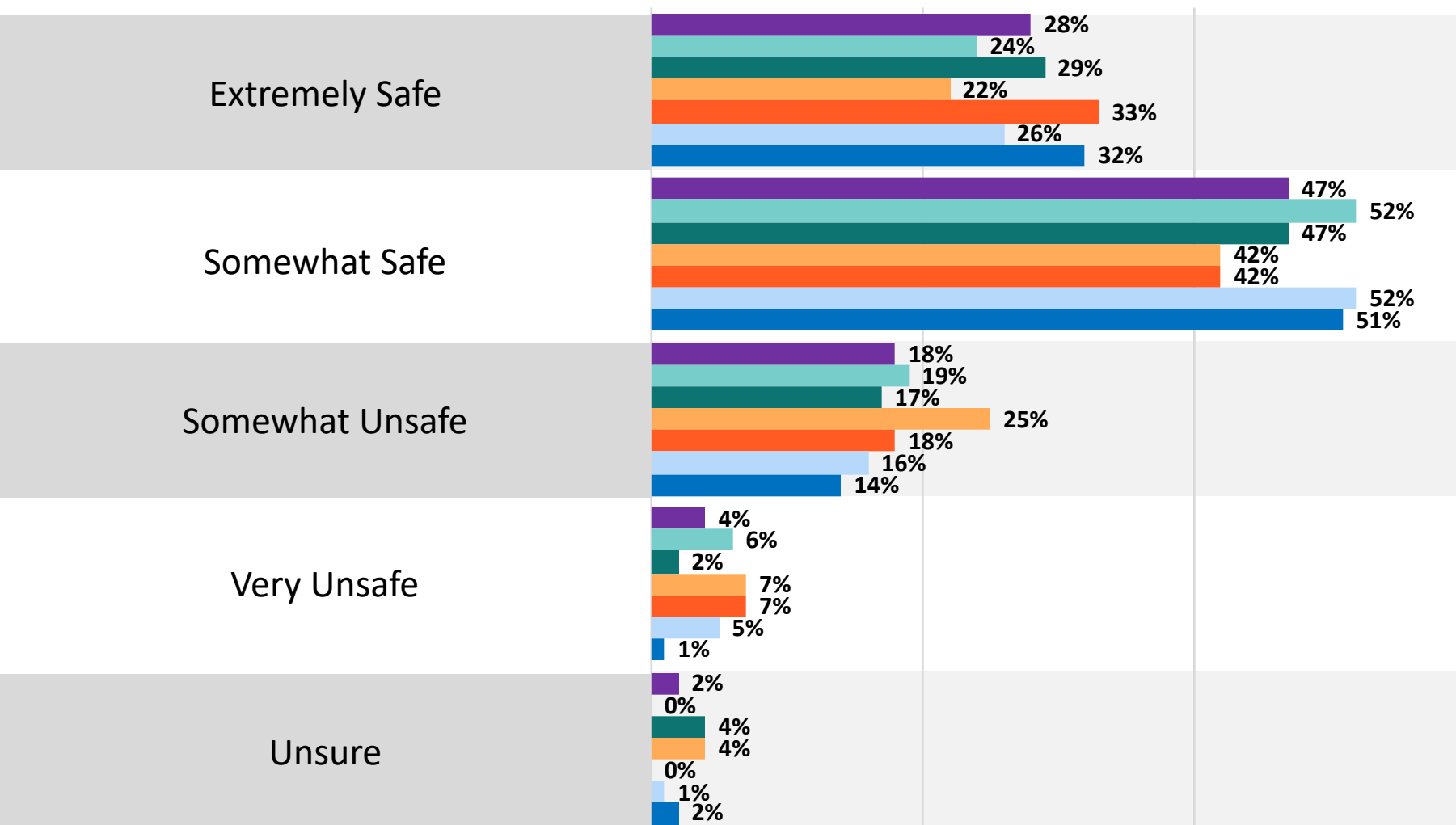

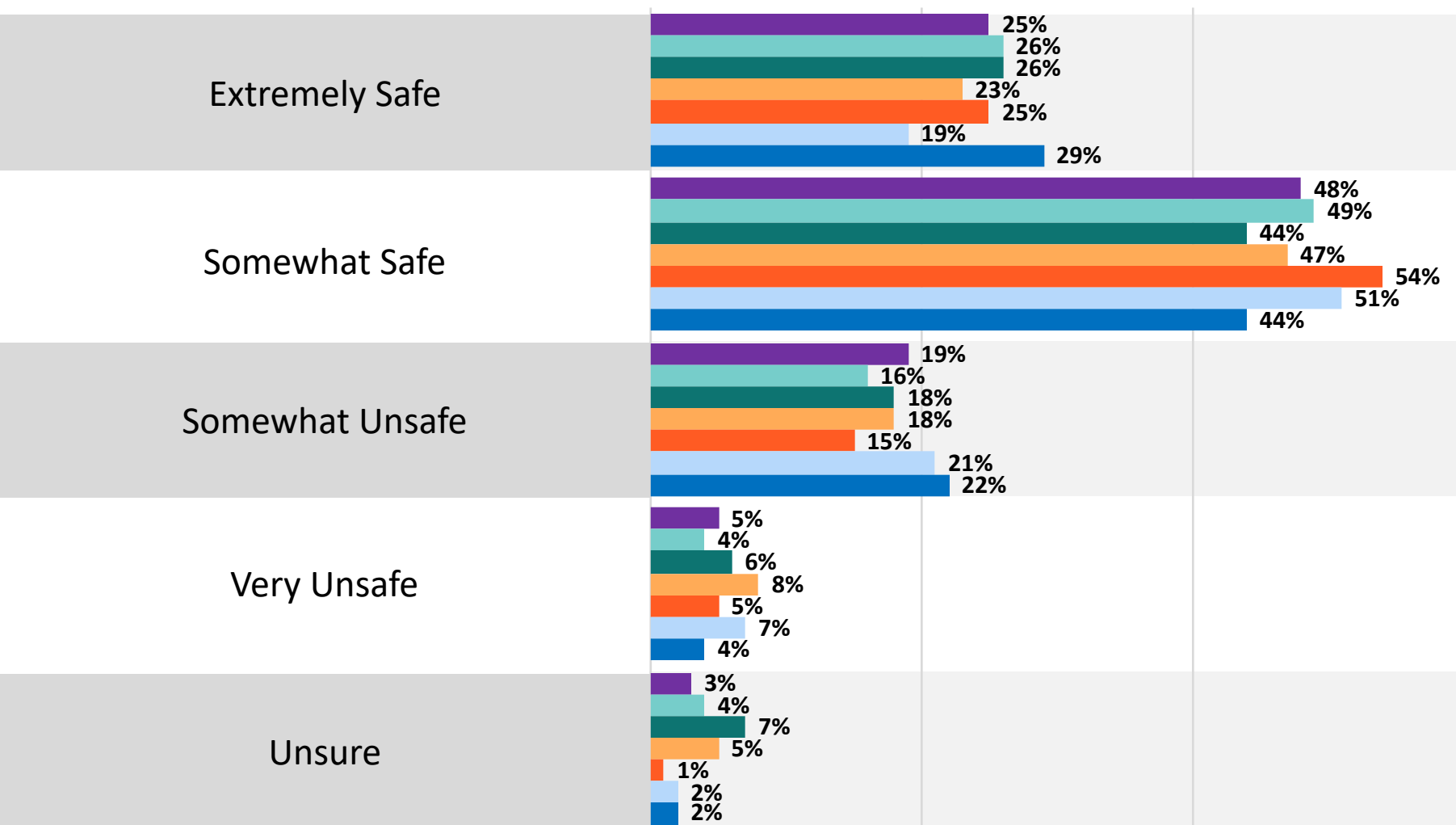

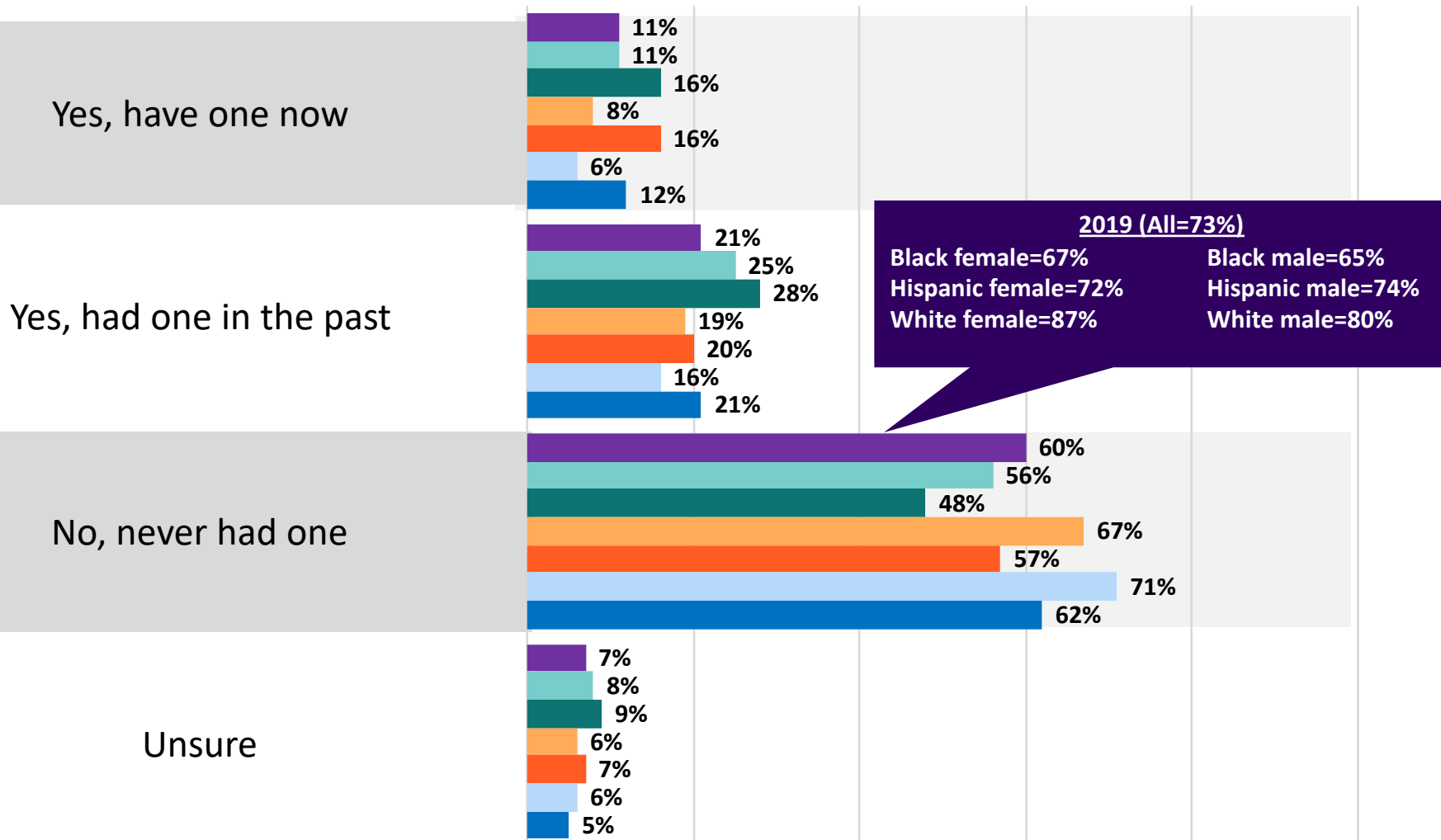

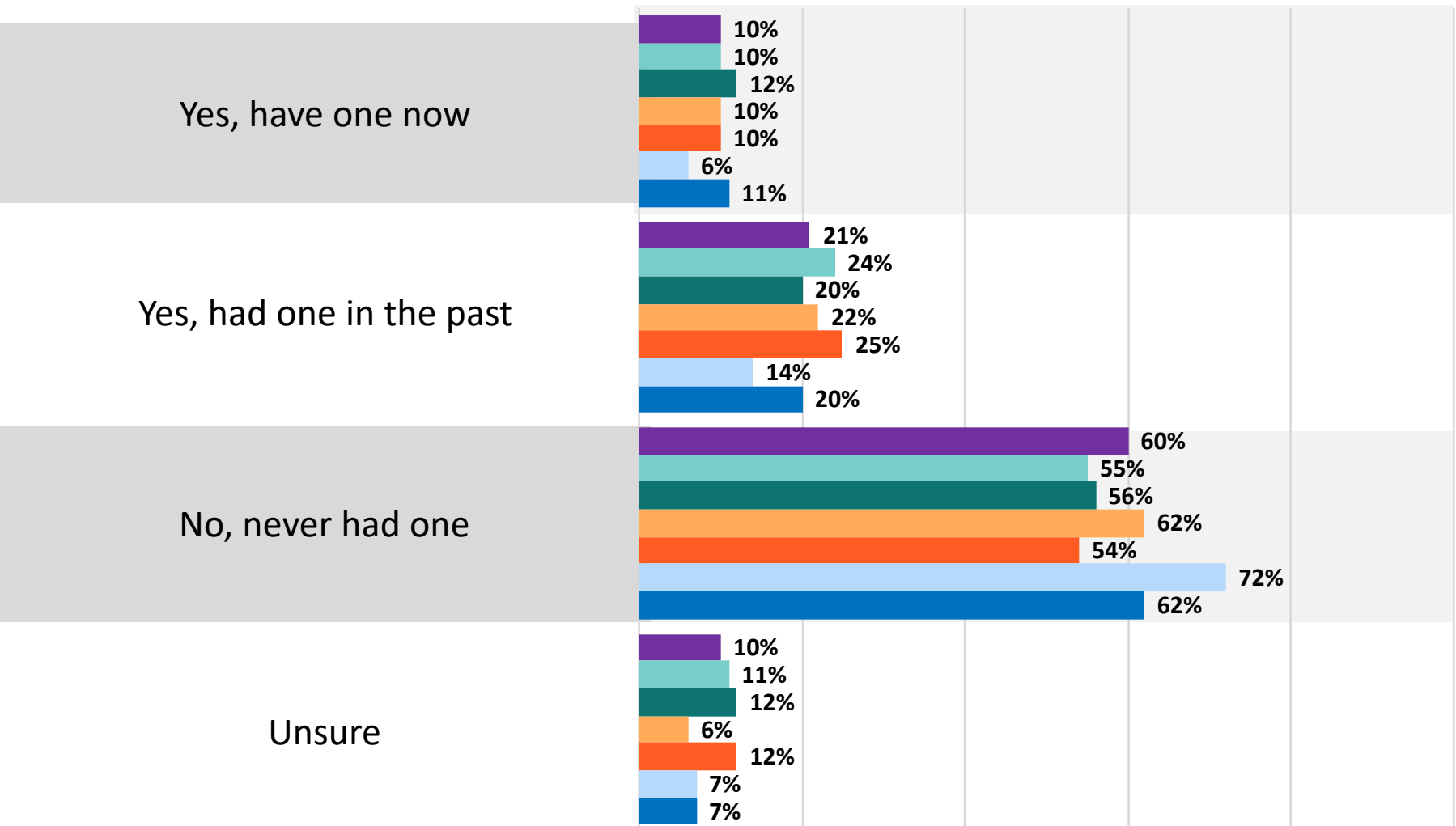

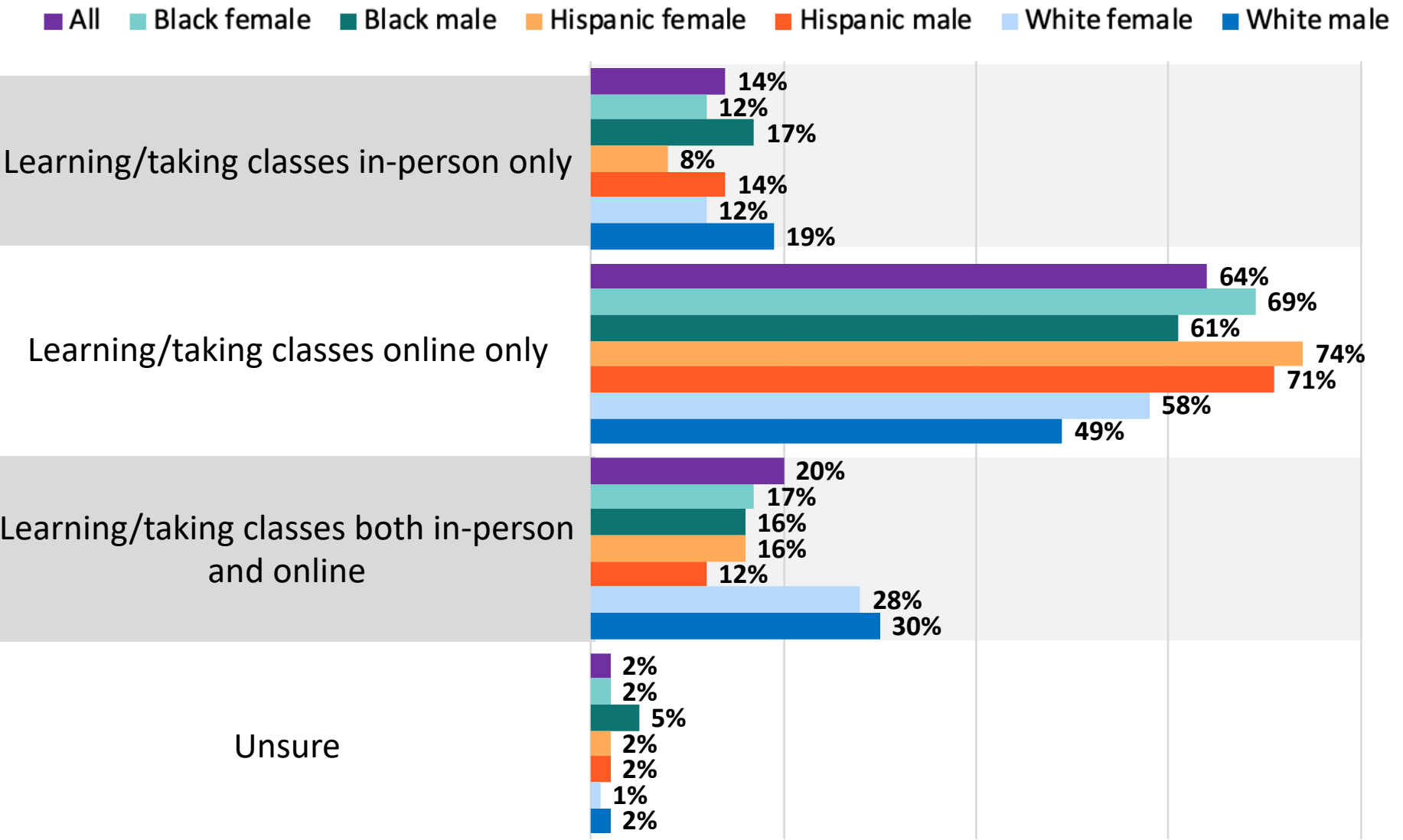

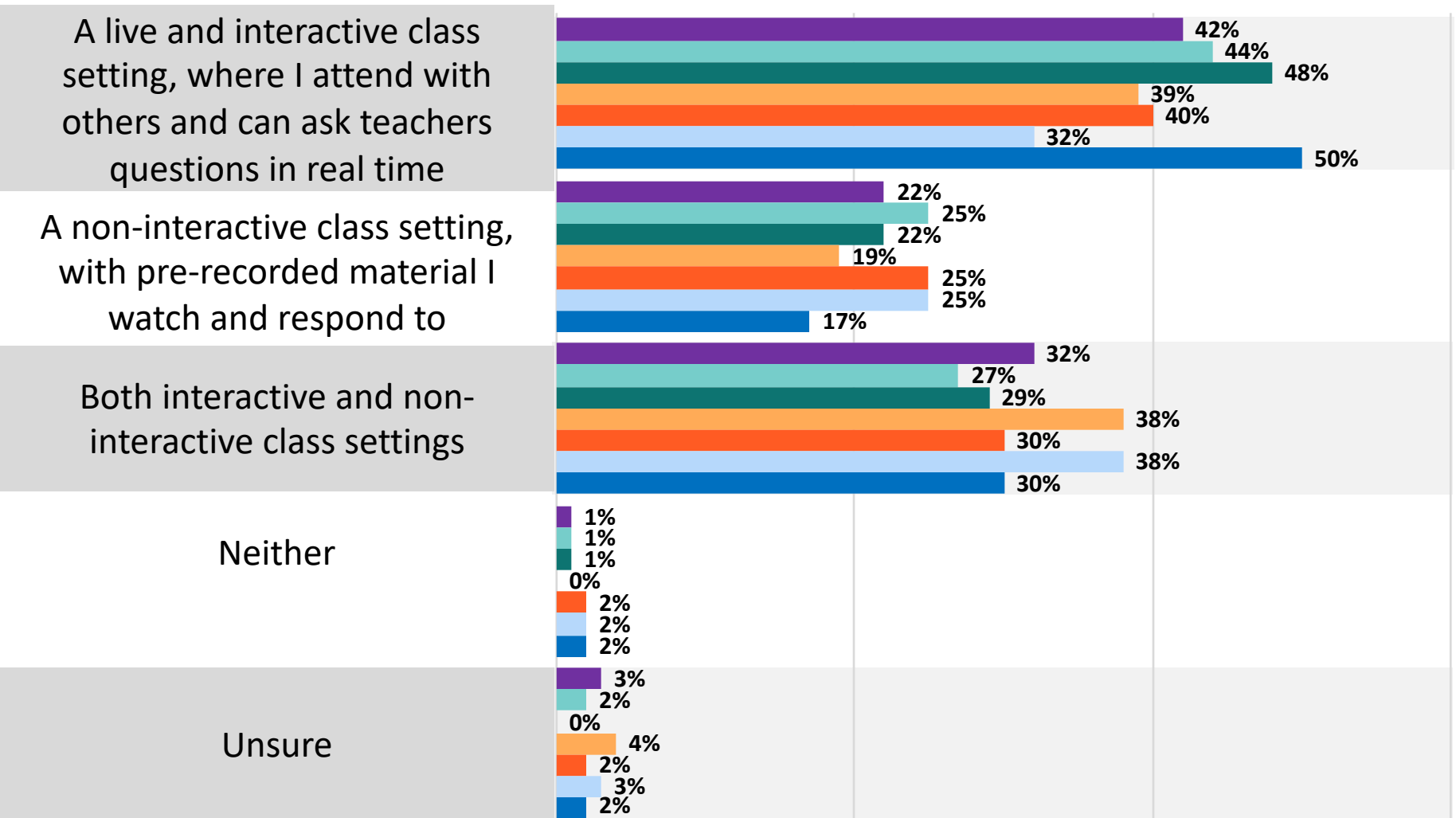

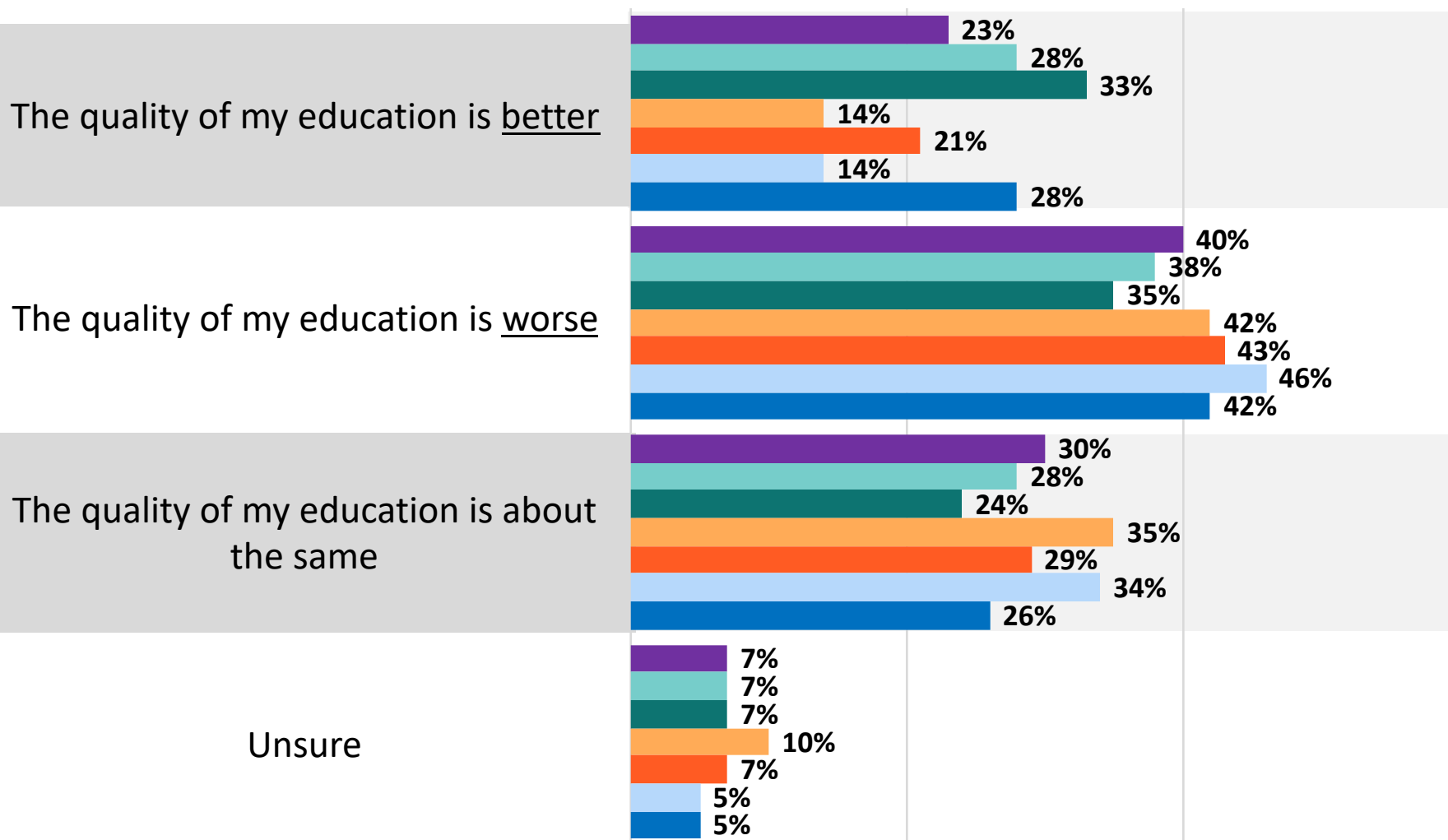

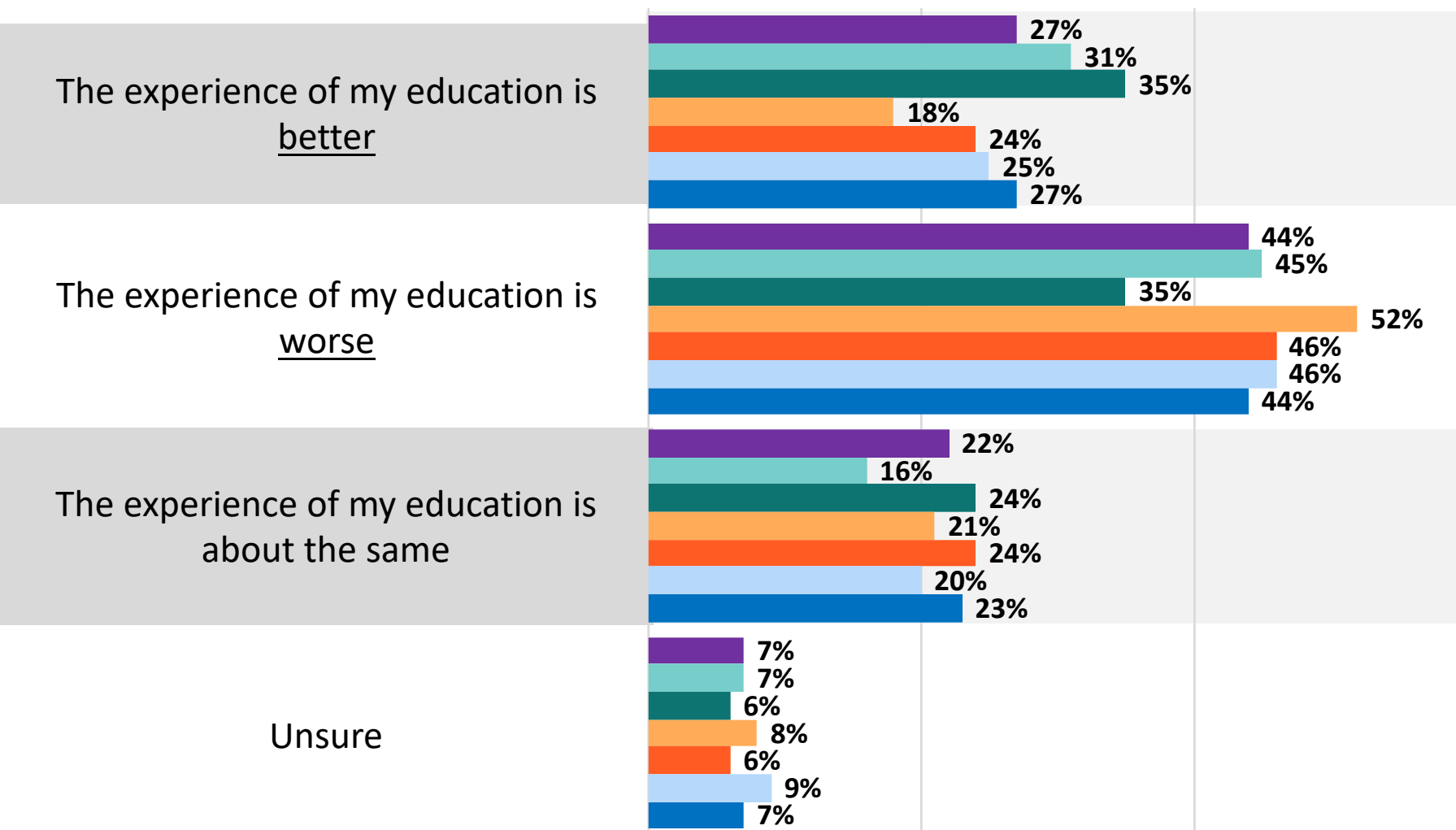

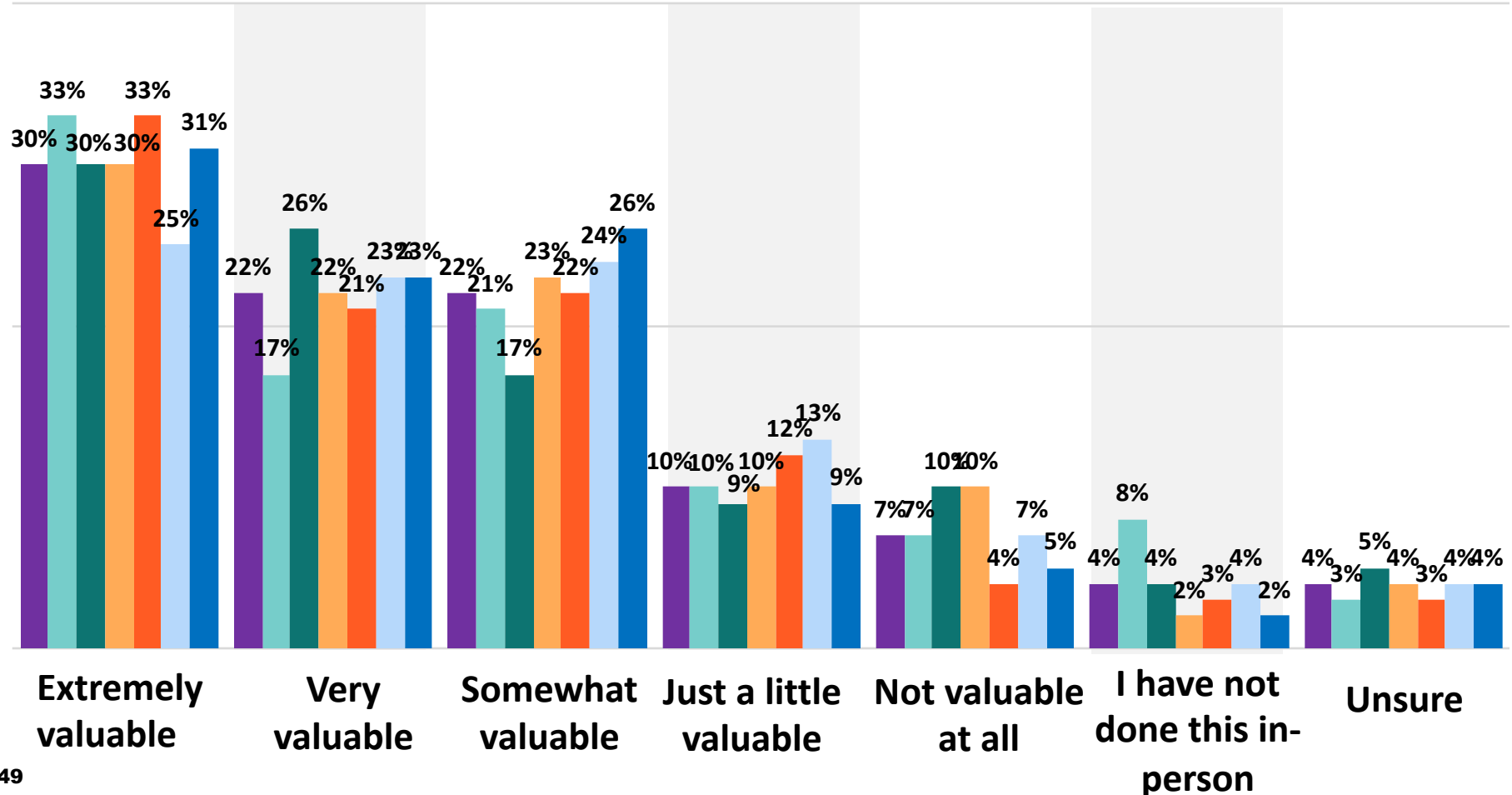

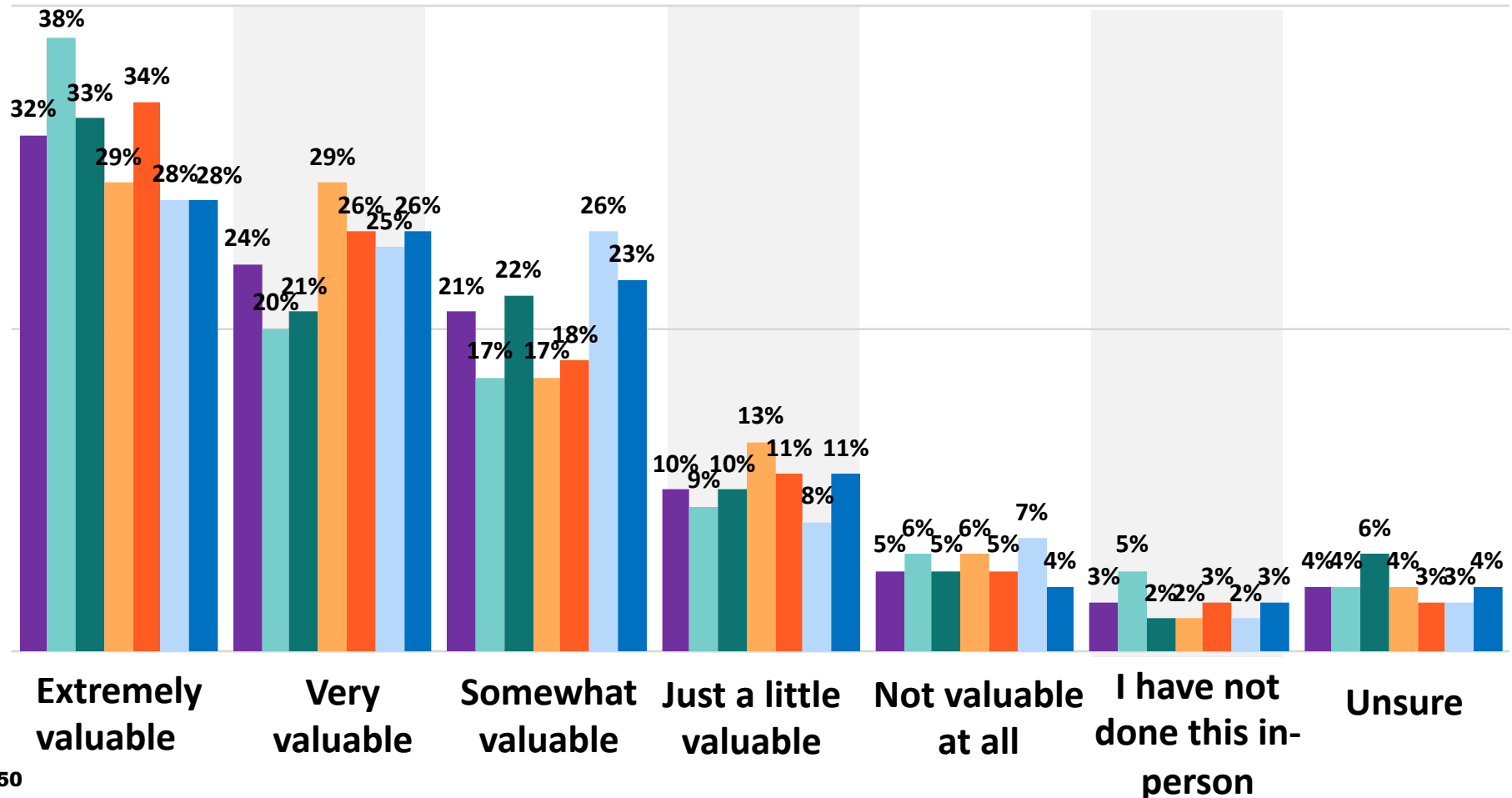

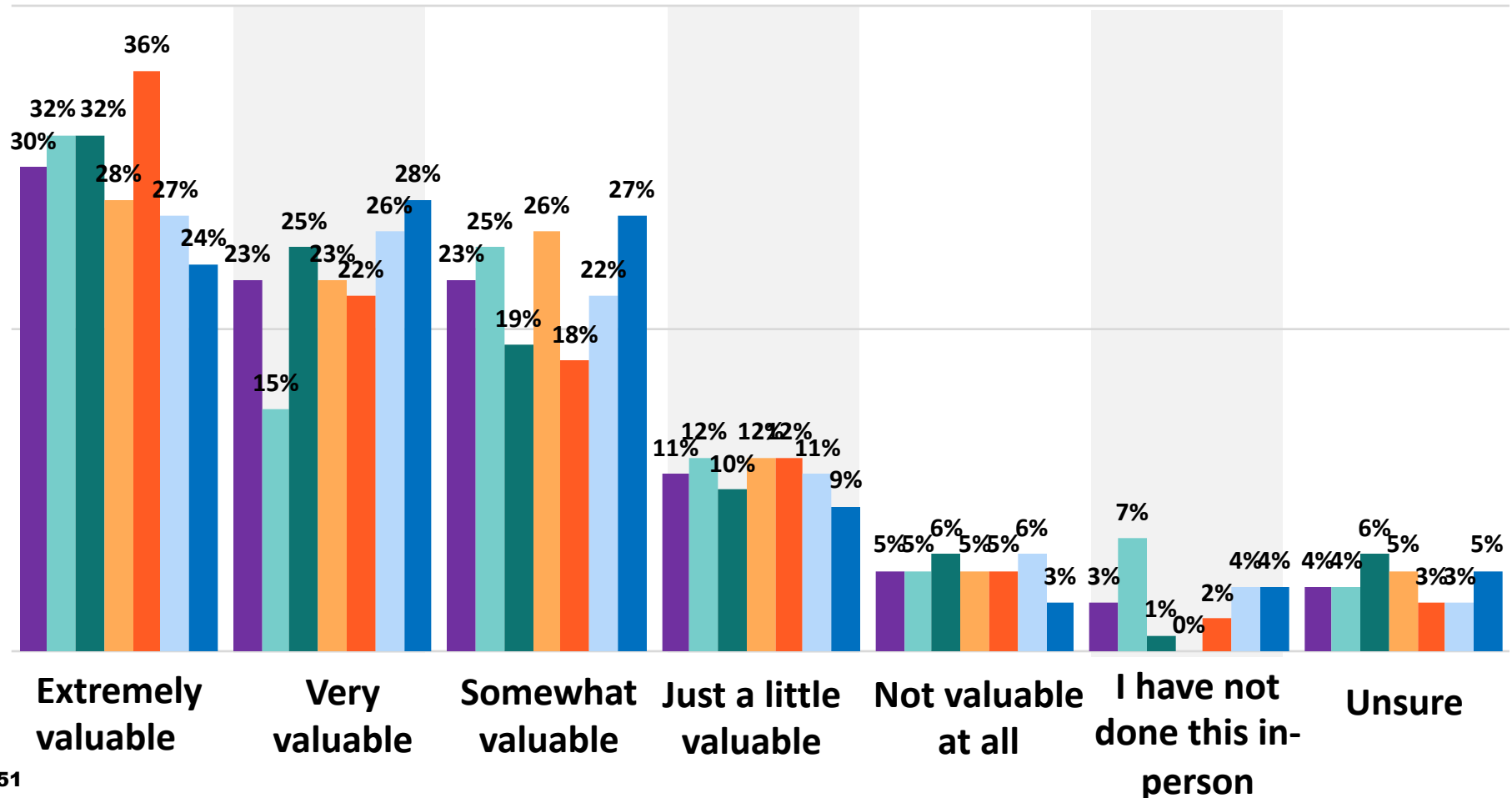

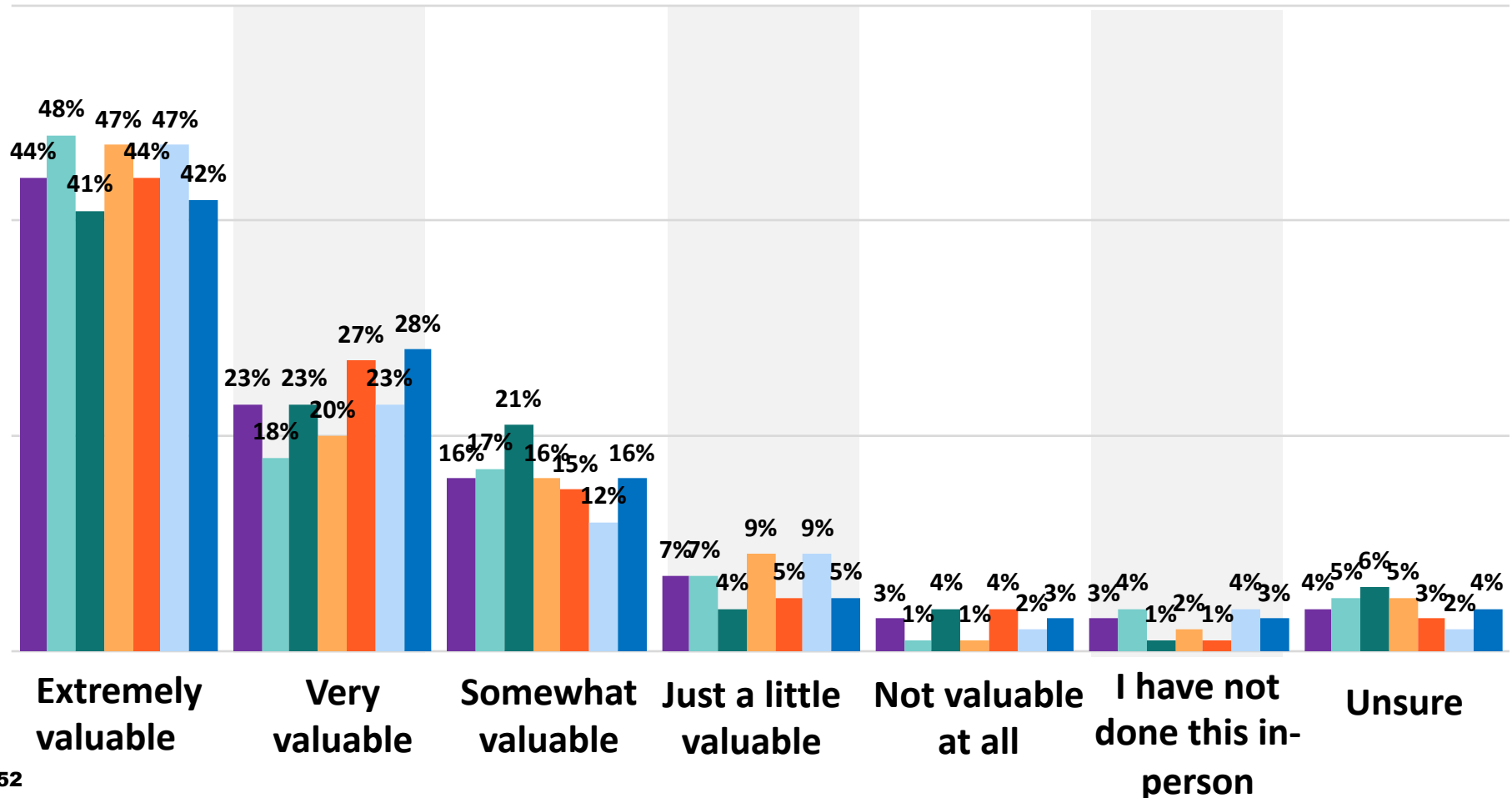

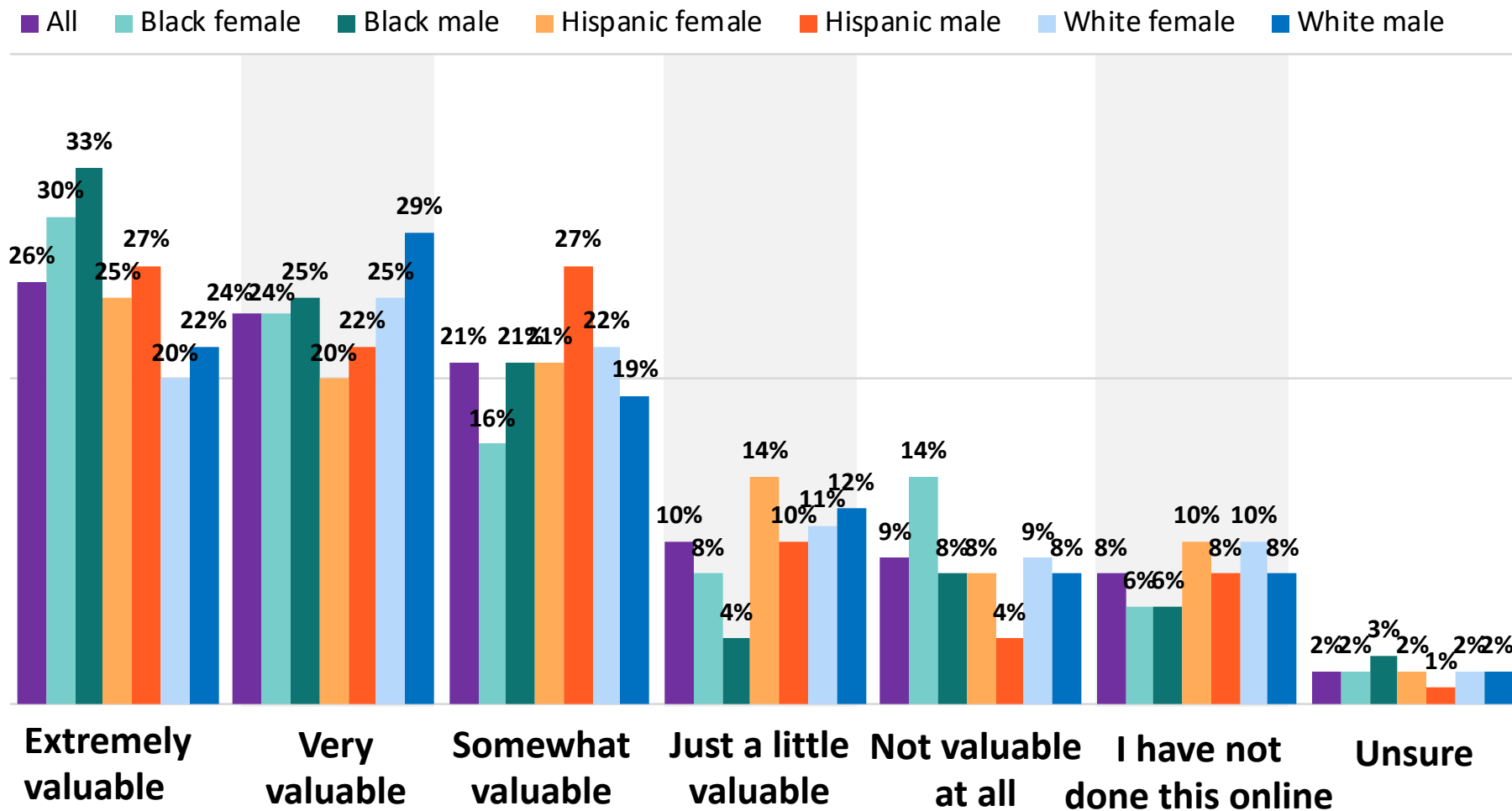

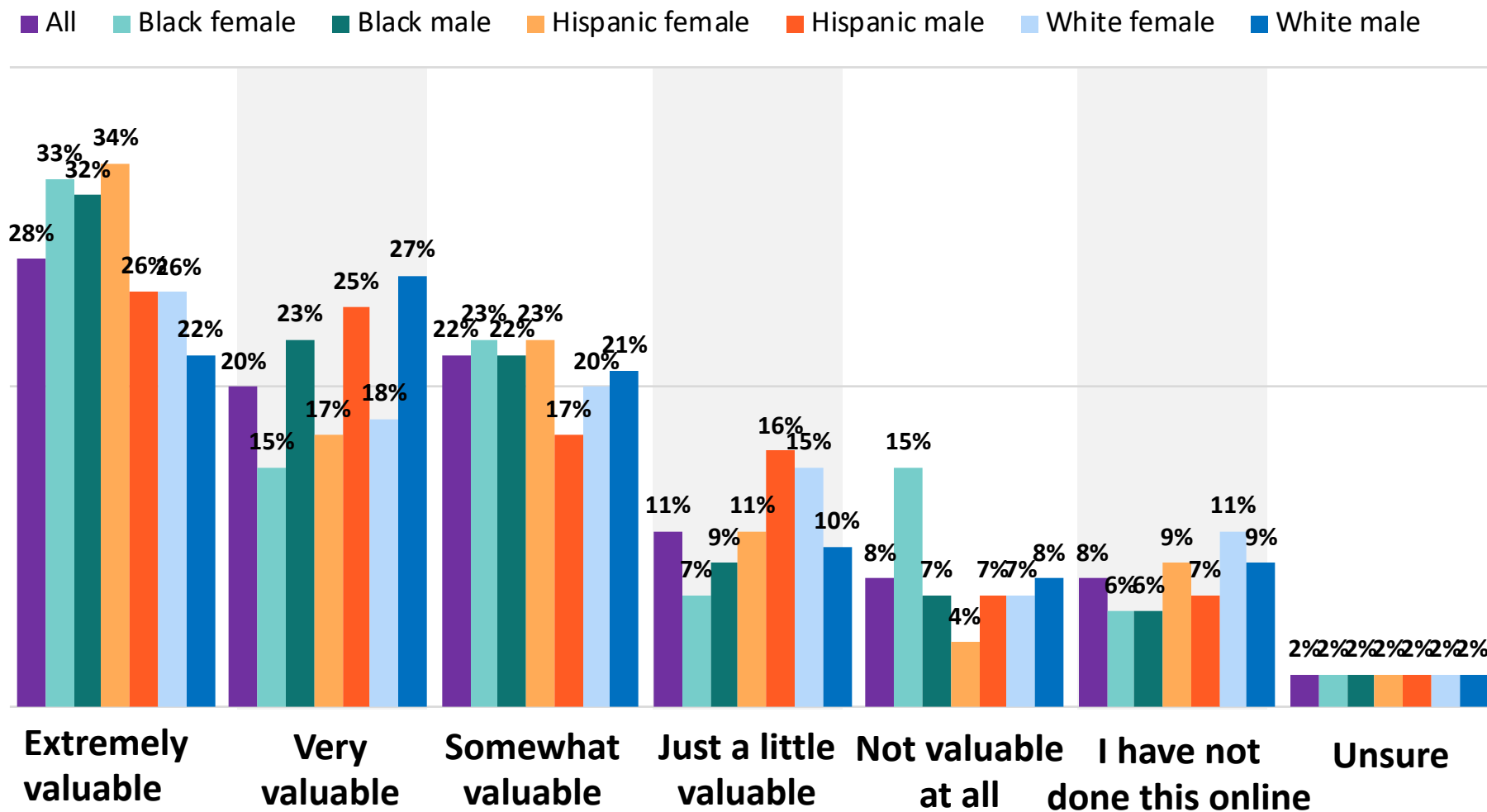

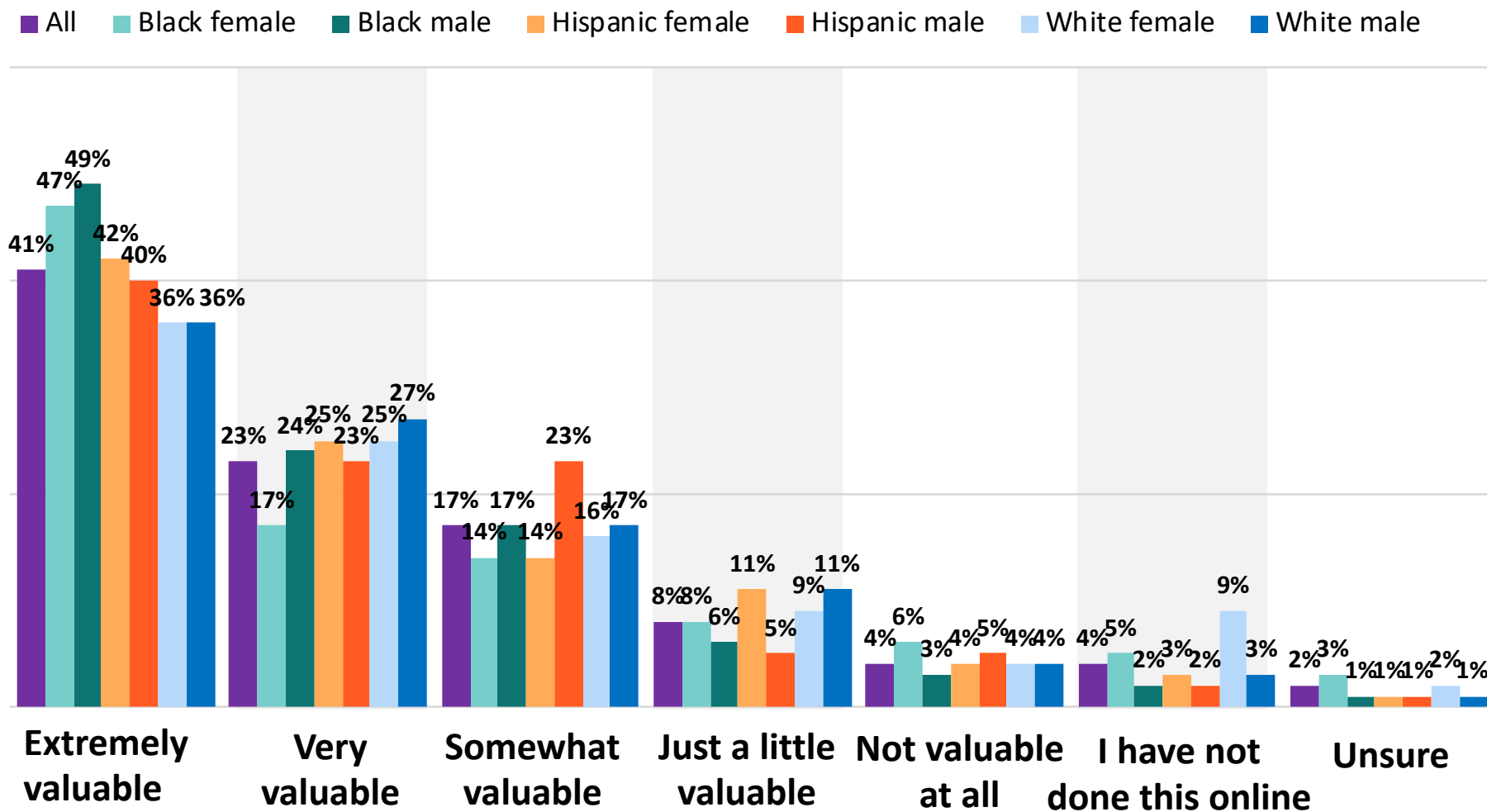

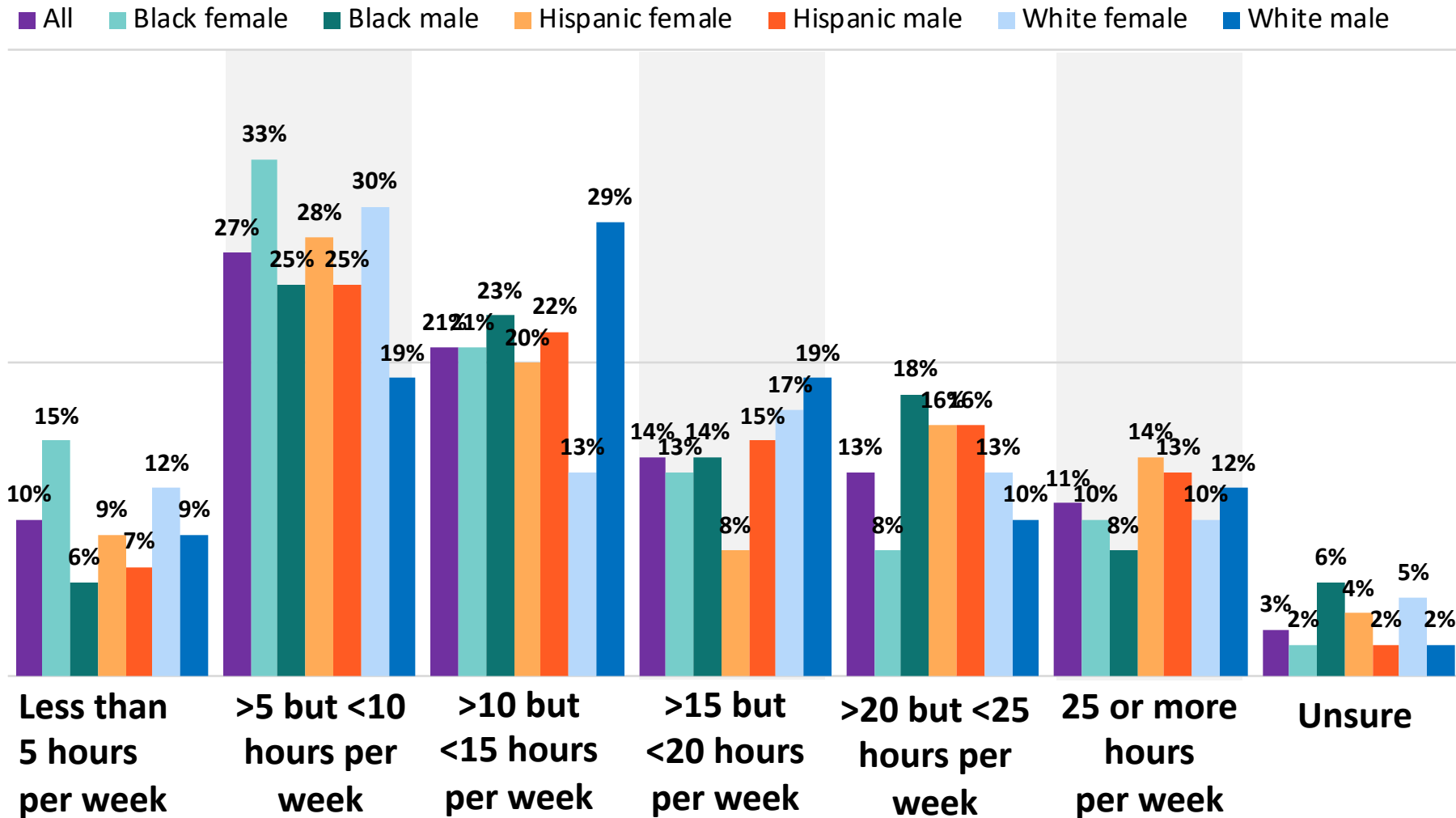

Hours of Online Learning (2020): Wave 2

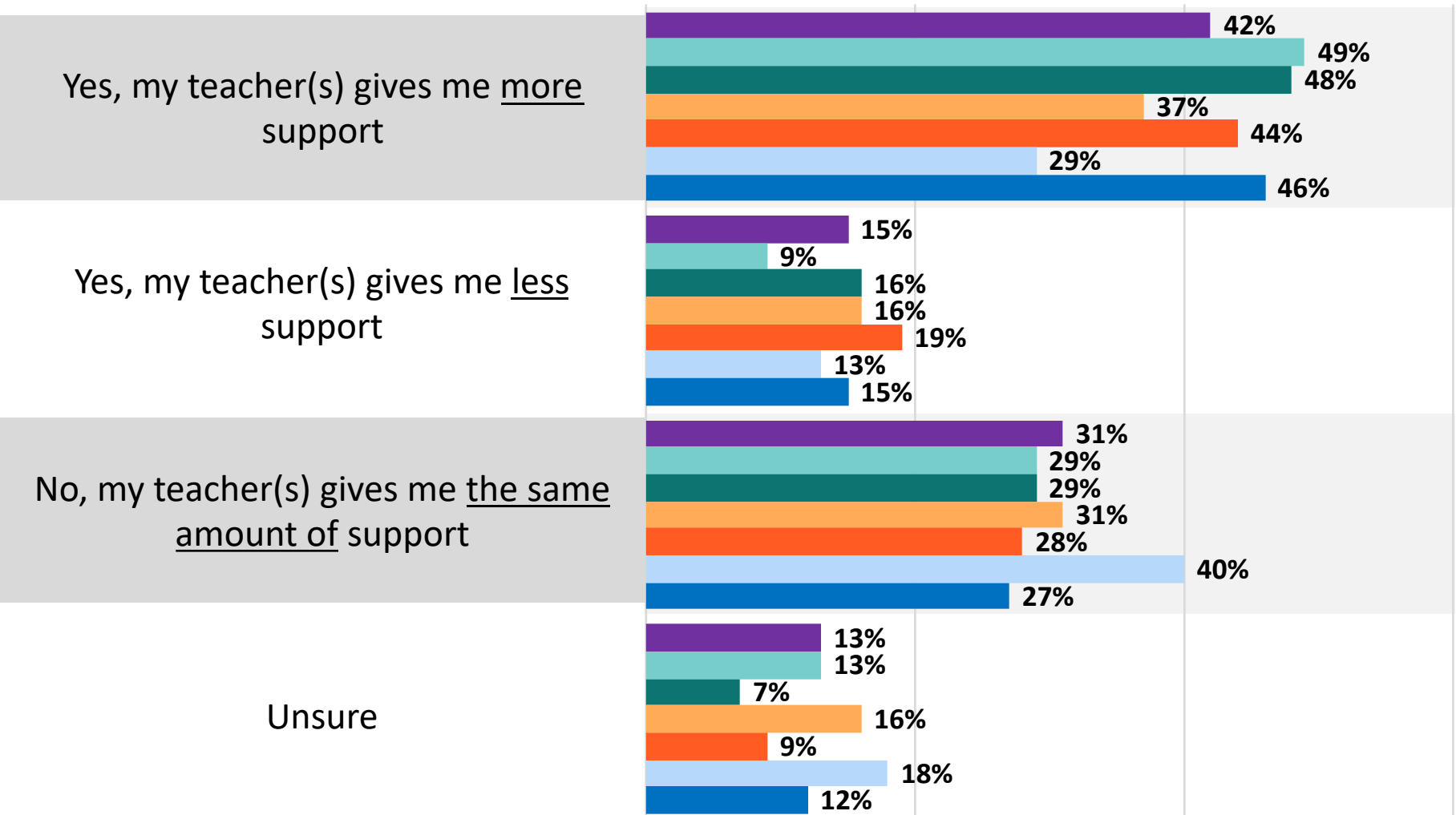
Generally speaking, how much time do you spend engaging in online or distance learning during a typical week while school has been in session this fall?

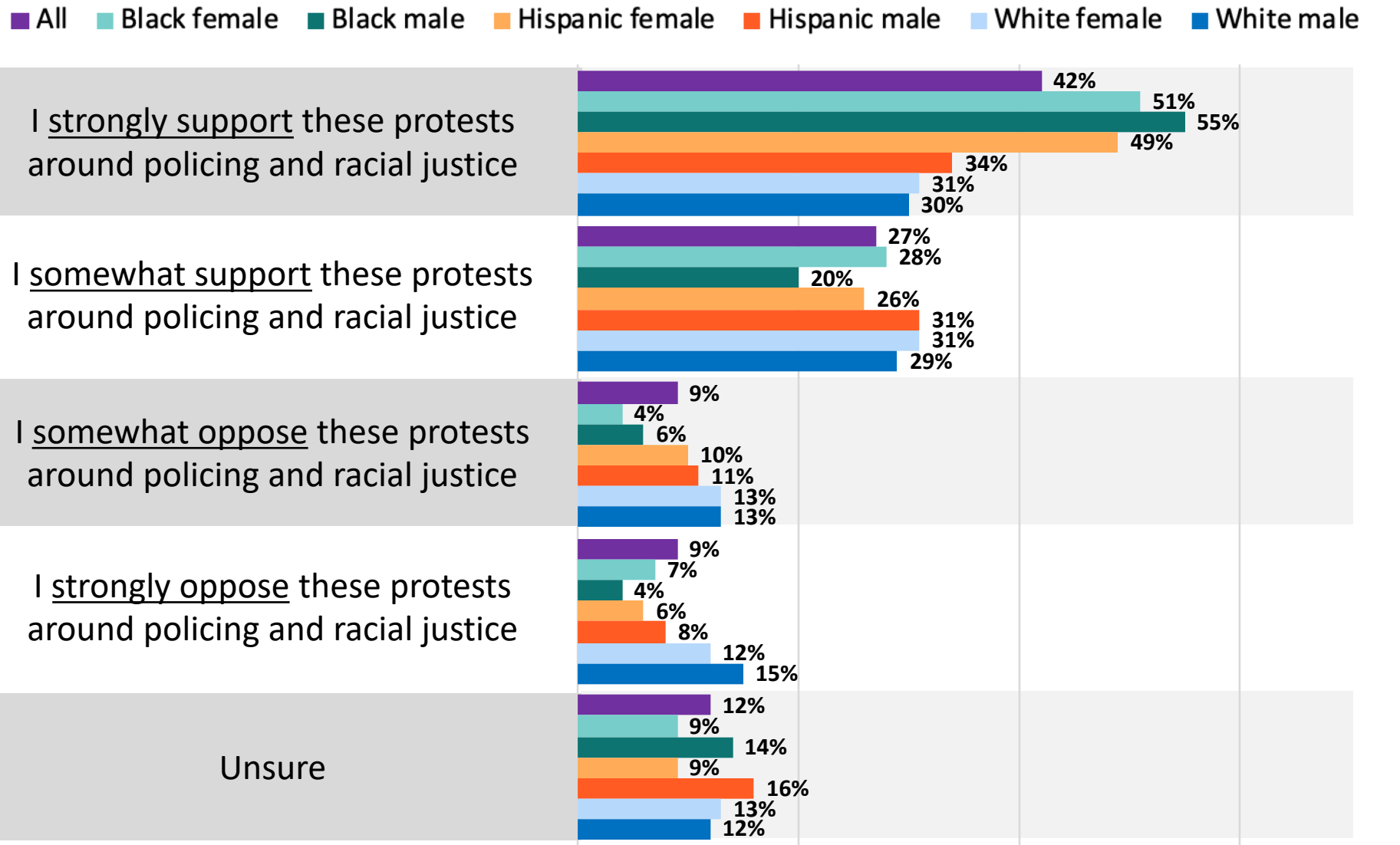

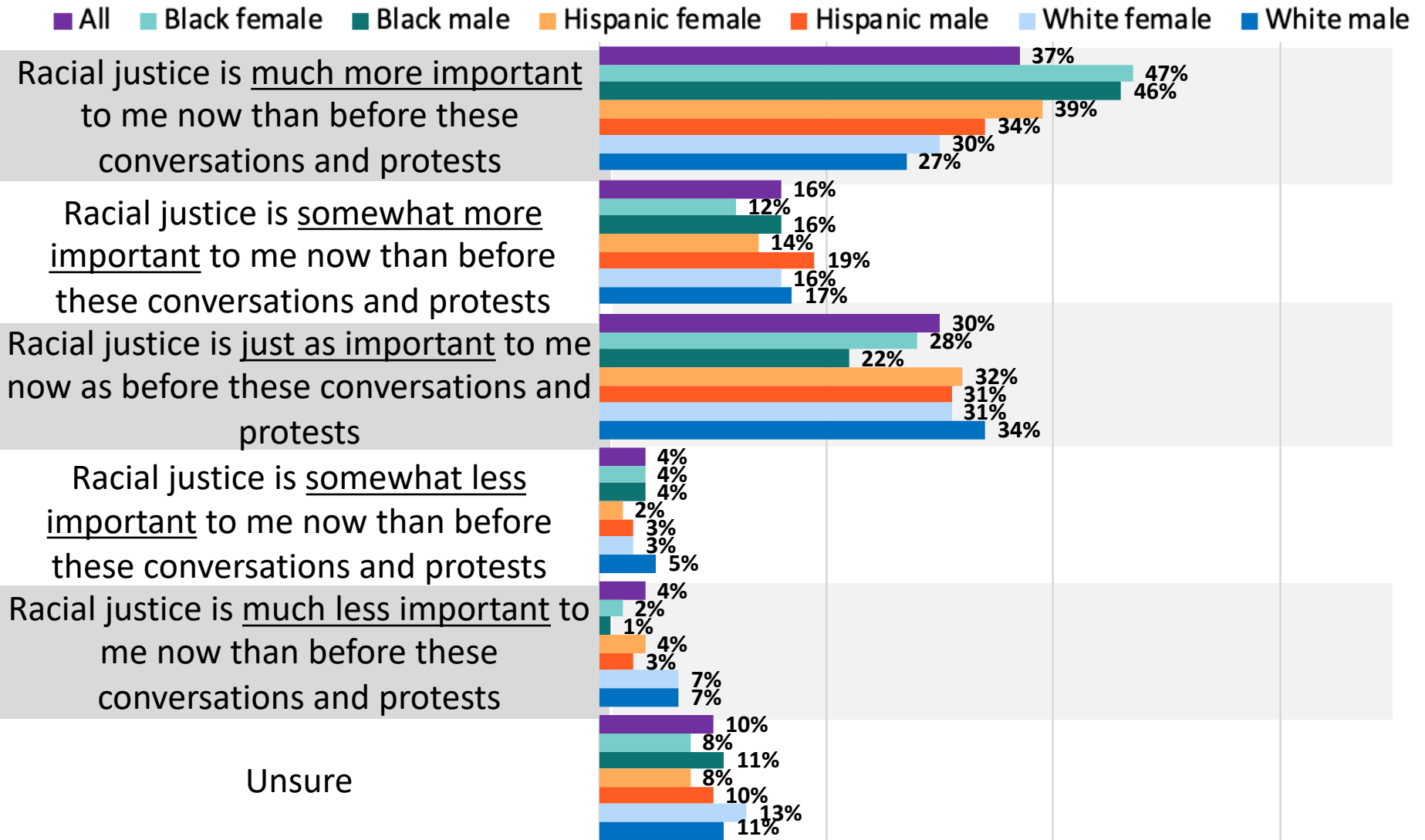

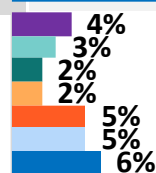

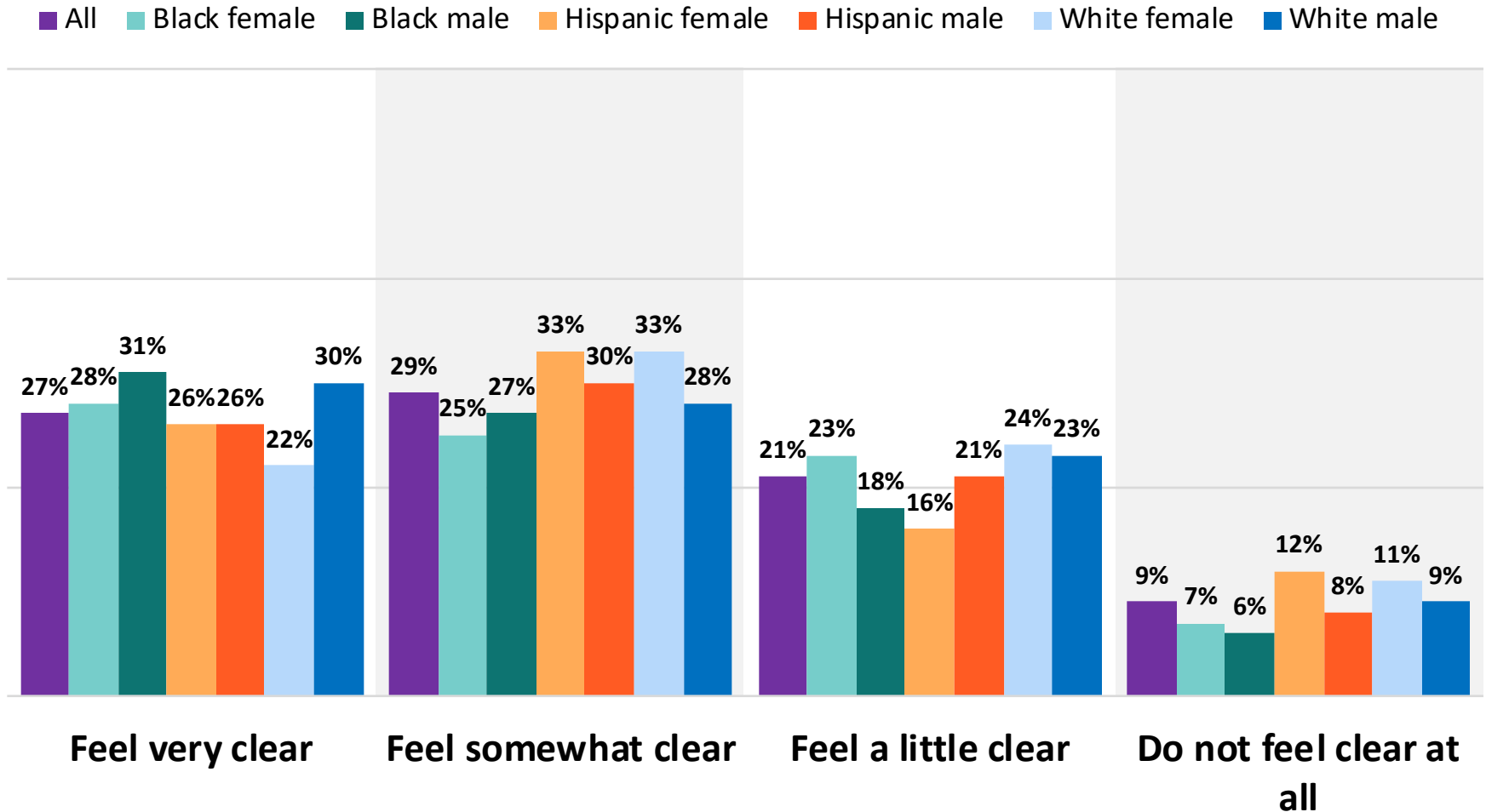

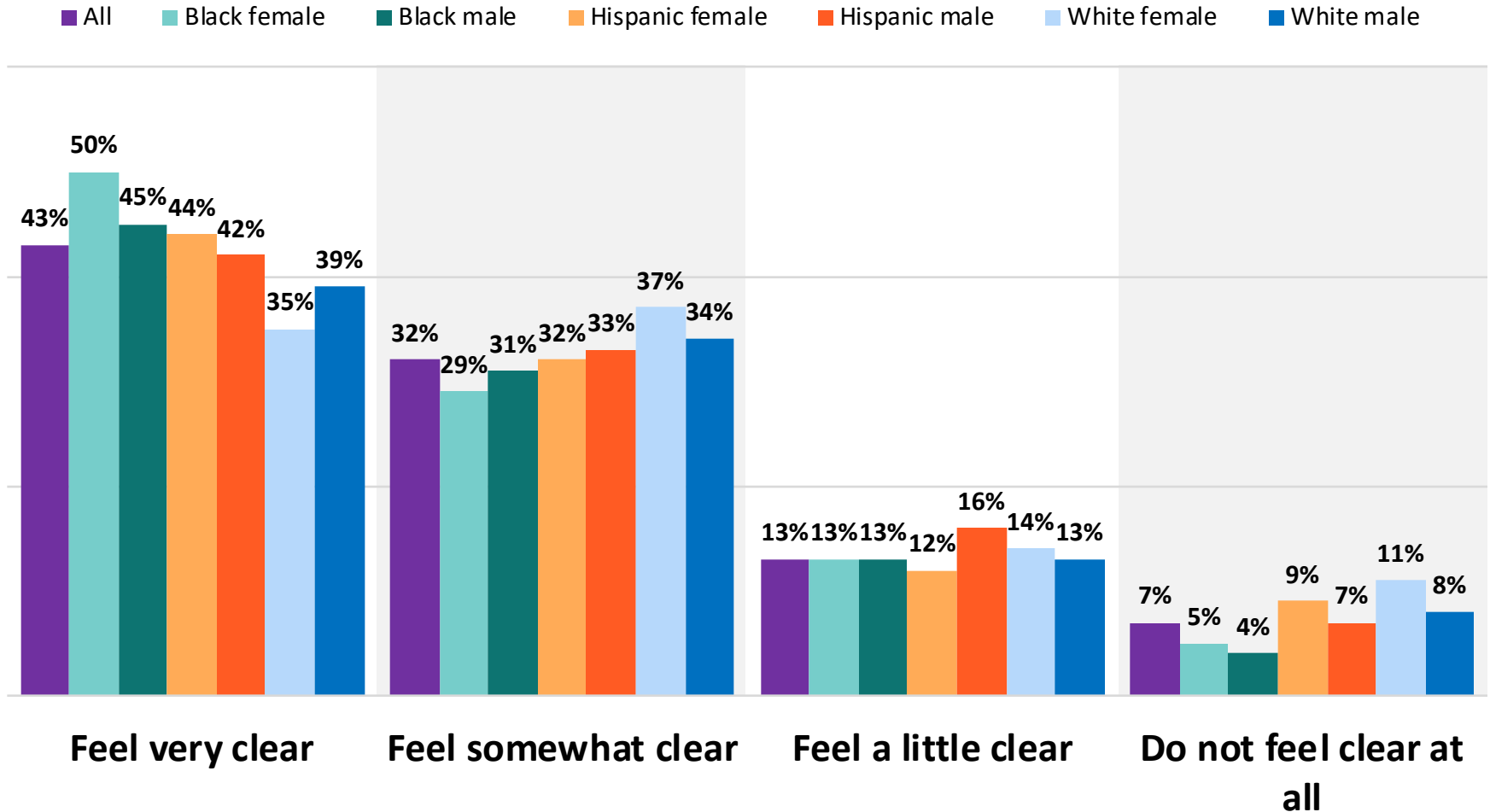

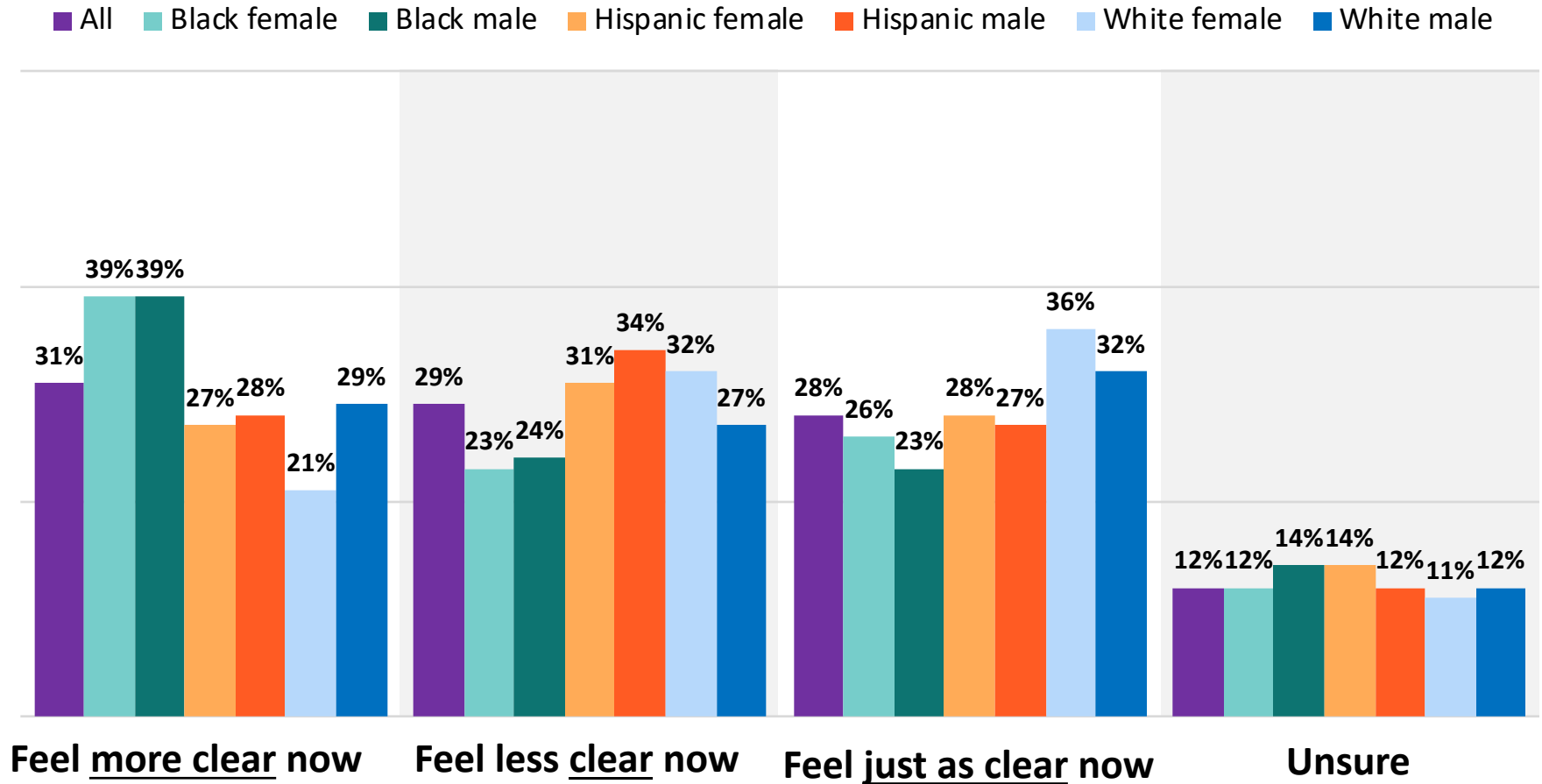

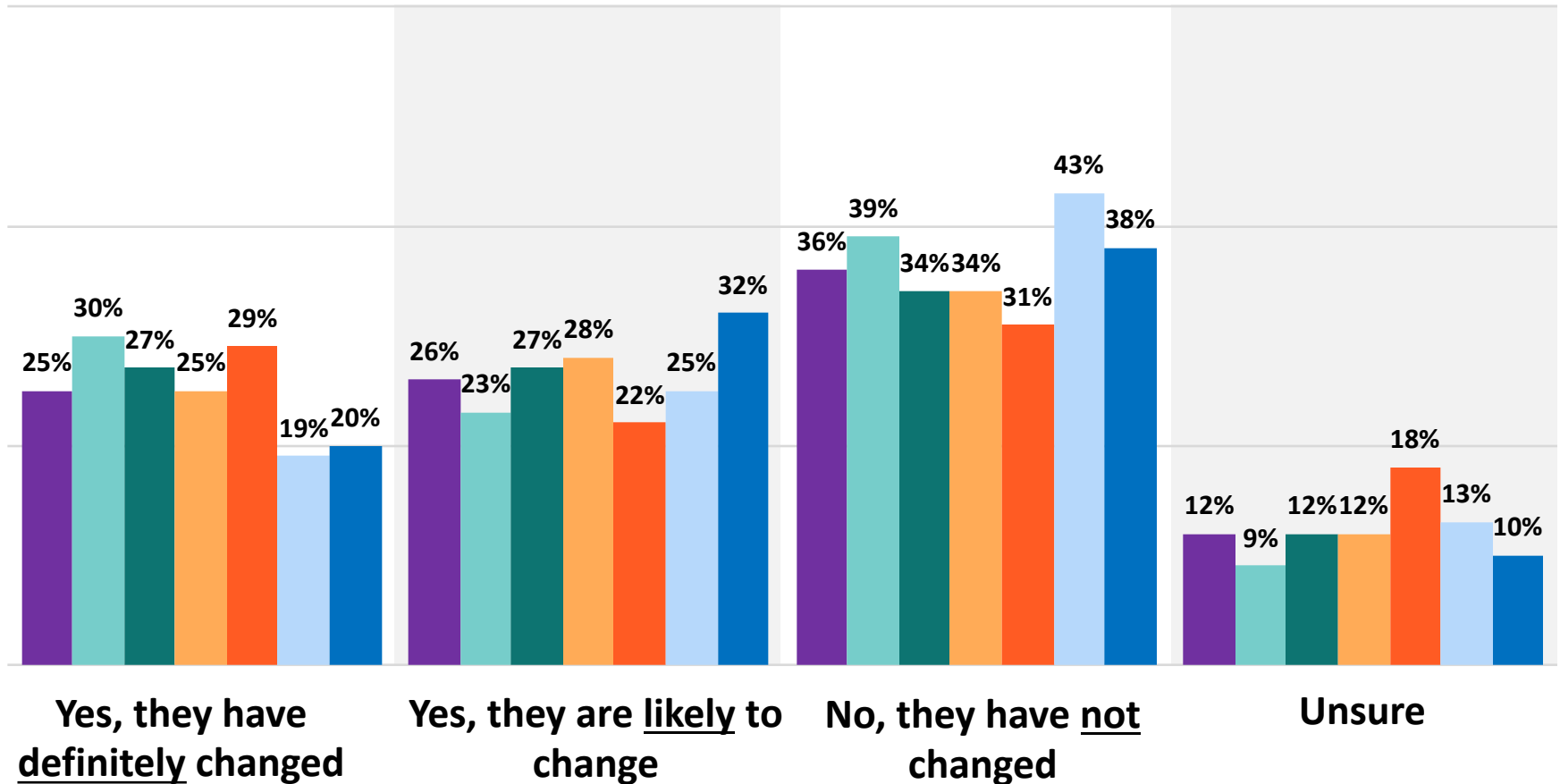

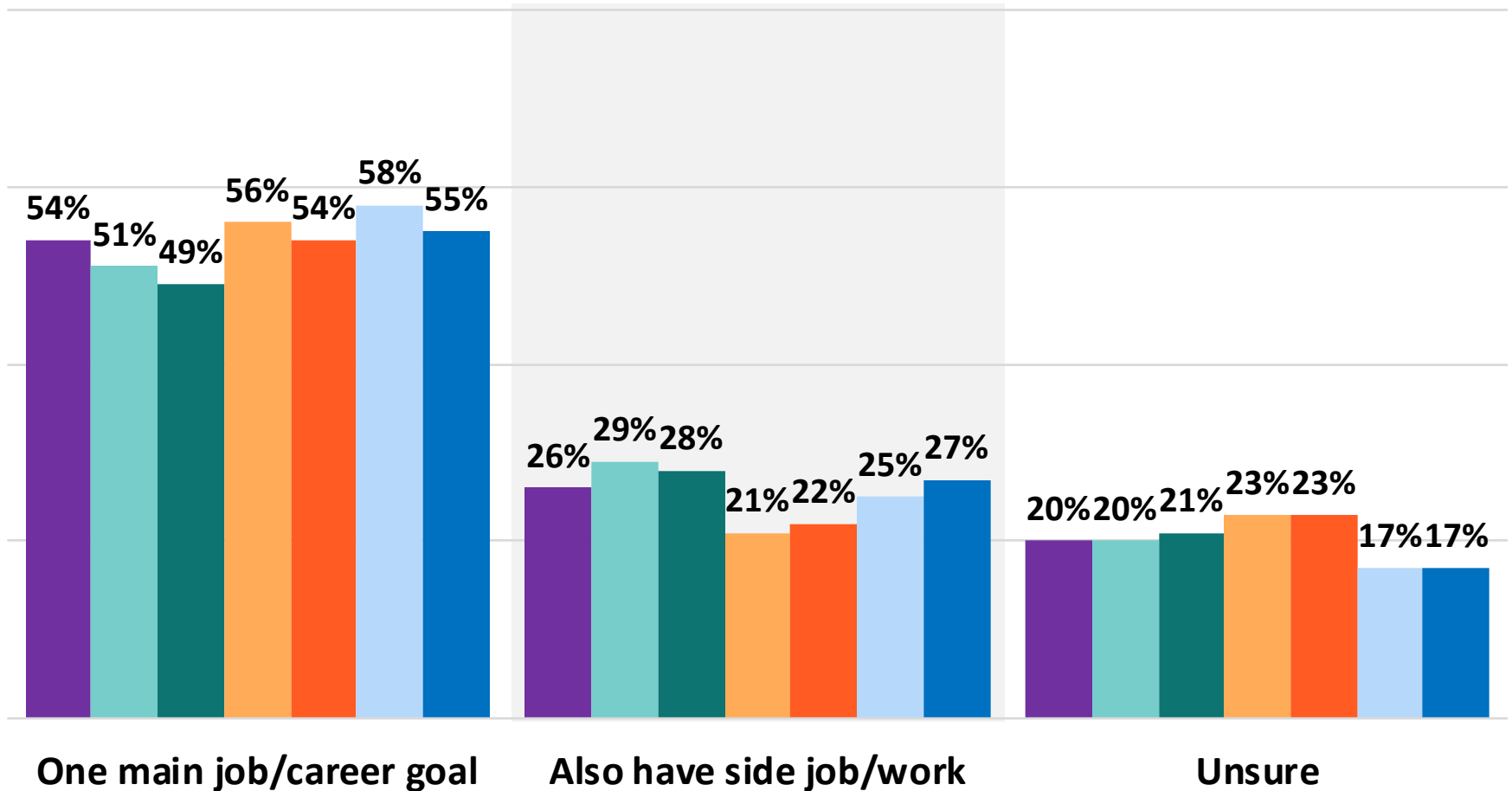

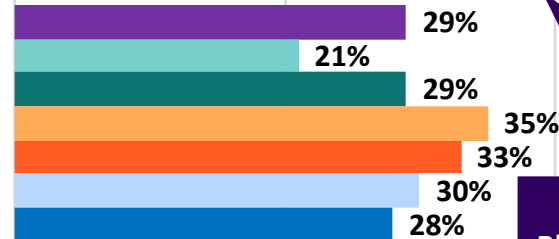

*How much do you personally feel weighed down by student debt?**

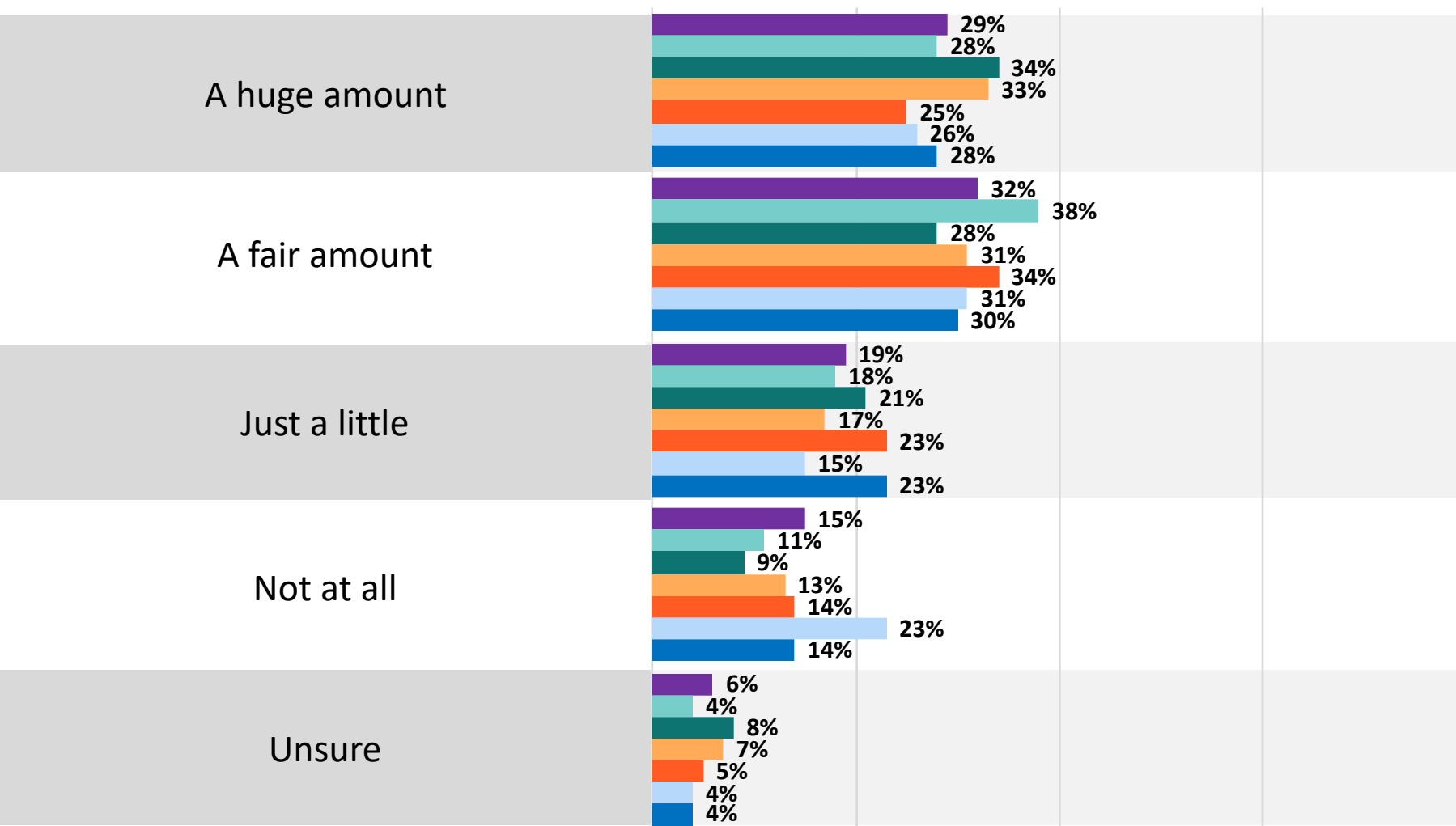

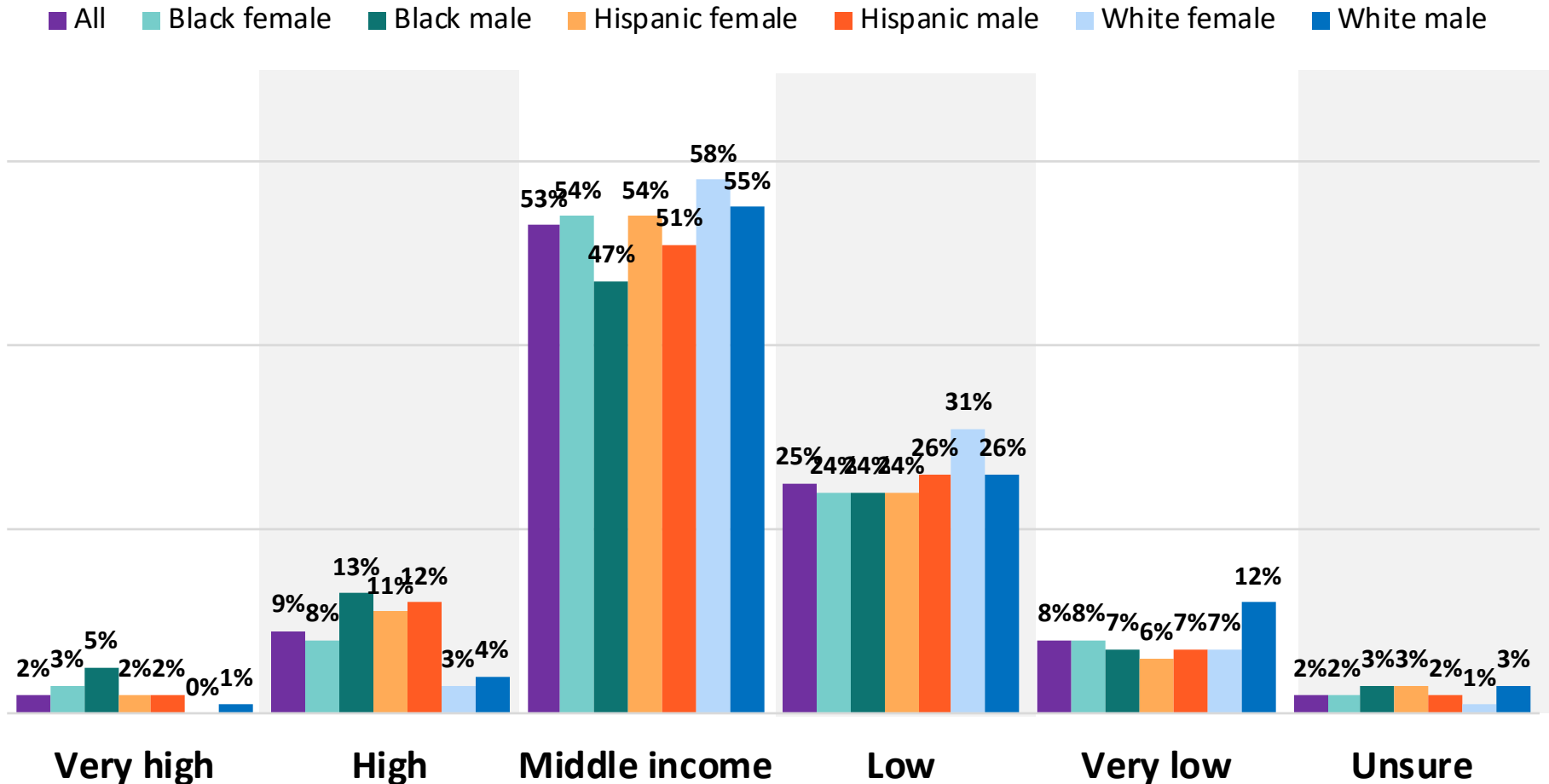
