






Across race, gender, and income level, fewer youth respondents in 2020 feel that they know what they want to do and the steps to get there.




























Do you think differently about college being worth it for you personally now than you did before the coronavirus outbreak?






















How much support do you feel you are receiving/receive from places or programs outside your high school about your plans after high school?
